Upon consideration of the First Interim Fee Application of PJT Partners LP as Investment Banker to the Debtors and Debtors in Possession for Allowance of Compensation for Services Rendered and for the Reimbursement of All Actual and Necessary Expenses Incurred for the Period of June 11, 2025 Through September 30, 2025 [Docket No. 1213] (the "Interim Fee Application") filed by PJT Partners LP ("PJT"), investment banker to the above-captioned debtors and debtors in possession (the "Debtors") in the above-captioned chapter 11 cases; and the United States District Court for the District of Delaware having jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1334, which was referred to this Court under 28 U.S.C. § 157 pursuant to the Amended Standing Order of Reference from the United States District Court for the District of Delaware, dated February 29, 2012; and the Court having found that this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); and the Court having found that it may enter a final order consistent with Article III of the United States Constitution; and the Court having found that venue of this

and 1409; and the Court having found that the relief requested in the Interim Fee Application is in

the best interests of the Debtors' estates, their creditors, and other parties in interest; and the Court

having found that notice of the Interim Fee Application and opportunity for a hearing thereon were

appropriate and no other notice need be provided; and the Court having reviewed the Interim Fee

Application and having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth therein establish just

cause for the relief granted herein; and upon all of the proceedings had before the Court; and after

due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Interim Fee Application is GRANTED.

2. PJT is allowed, on an interim basis, compensation in the amount of \$9,218,579.67

and actual and necessary expenses in the amount of \$800.90<sup>2</sup> for the period from June 11, 2025

through and including September 30, 2025.

3. The Debtors are authorized to make payment to PJT on account of any of the

outstanding fees and expenses as provided for herein that have not yet been paid in connection

with any monthly fee statements previously filed by PJT.

This Court shall retain jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related 4.

to the implementation, interpretation, and enforcement of this Order.
