PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT a hearing will be held on **Tuesday, May 13, 2025, at 10:30 a.m.** (the "Hearing"), and will take place at the United States Bankruptcy Court, 1300 Clay Street, Oakland, California, before the Honorable William J. Lafferty, United States Bankruptcy Judge, to consider the *Joint Motion Filed By The Debtor and 85 Clergy Employees of The Debtor To Quash and Motion for Protection Against Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors' Subpoenas Served on The Debtor's Clergy Employees* (the "Motion"), filed concurrently

of Oakland, a California corporation sole, and the debtor and debtor in possession (the “Debtor”) in the above-captioned chapter 11 bankruptcy case (the “Bankruptcy Case”), together with 85 of its clergy employees (collectively, the “Clergy Employees” and, together with the Debtor, the “Movants”).

The Motion seeks an order either (1) quashing the 85 subpoenas (the “Clergy Employee Subpoenas”) served by the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (the “Committee”) on the Debtor’s Clergy Employees in their entirety or (2) prohibiting enforcement of the Clergy Employee Subpoenas.

Box 2070, Oakland, California, 94604) and must be served on counsel for the Debtor at the address listed above. Unless a timely objection is filed, the Court may grant the relief requested in the Motion without a hearing. **Failure to file and serve a timely objection may result in the waiver of any objection.**
