MOTION OF THE DEBTORS FOR ENTRY OF ORDERS (I)(A) ESTABLISHING BIDDING PROCEDURES RELATING TO THE SALE OF THE DEBTORS' ASSETS, (B) APPROVING THE DEBTORS' ENTRY INTO THE STALKING HORSE PURCHASE AGREEMENTS AND RELATED BID PROTECTIONS, (C) ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES RELATING TO THE ASSUMPTION AND ASSIGNMENT OF CERTAIN EXECUTORY CONTRACTS AND UNEXPIRED LEASES, (D) APPROVING FORM AND MANNER OF NOTICES RELATING THERETO, (E) SCHEDULING A HEARING TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSED SALE, AND (F) GRANTING RELATED RELIEF; AND (II)(A) APPROVING THE SALE OF THE DEBTORS' ASSETS FREE AND CLEAR OF ALL LIENS, CLAIMS, ENCUMBRANCES, AND INTERESTS, (B) AUTHORIZING THE ASSUMPTION AND ASSIGNMENT OF CERTAIN EXECUTORY CONTRACTS AND UNEXPIRED LEASES, AND (C) GRANTING RELATED RELIEF

The above-captioned debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, the "<u>Debtors</u>"), submit this amendment to the *Motion of the Debtors for Entry of Orders (I)(A) Establishing Bidding Procedures Relating to the Sale of the Debtors' Assets, (B) Approving the Debtors' Entry into the Stalking Horse Purchase Agreements and Related Bid Protections, (C) Establishing Procedures Relating to the Assumption and Assignment of Certain Executory Contracts and Unexpired Leases, (D) Approving Form and Manner of Notices Relating Thereto, (E) Scheduling*

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a Hearing to Consider the Proposed Sale, and (F) Granting Related Relief; and (II)(A) Approving the Sale of the Debtors' Assets Free and Clear of All Liens, Claims, Encumbrances, and Interests, (B) Authorizing the Assumption and Assignment of Certain Executory Contracts and Unexpired Leases, and (C) Granting Related Relief [D.I. 34] (the "Motion"),² and respectfully state as follows:

1. On March 18, 2025, the Debtors the filed the Motion seeking entry of the Bidding Procedures Order, substantially in the form attached to the Motion as **Exhibit A**: (a) approving the Bidding Procedures, by which the Debtors will solicit and select the highest or otherwise best offer for the Sale of the Assets, (b) approving the Debtors' selection of the Stalking Horse Bidders pursuant to the Stalking Horse Purchase Agreements and the Bid Protections, (c) establishing the Assumption and Assignment Procedures, (d) approving the form and manner of notice of all procedures, protections, schedules, and agreements related to the Sale, (e) scheduling the Sale Hearing to approve the Sale, and (f) granting related relief.

2. In Paragraph 19 of the Motion, the Debtors included a summary chart of the Break-Up Fee and Expense Reimbursement for each Stalking Horse Bidder that the Debtors seek to approve via entry of the Bidding Procedures Order. With respect to East Coast Mechanical Home Services LLC (i.e., the ECM Stalking Horse Bidder), the summary chart incorrectly reflected an Expense Reimbursement of \$380,000 instead of \$480,000 as provided for in the ECM Stalking Horse Purchase Agreement § 8.3(a). Accordingly, the summary chart of Paragraph 19 of the Motion is amended as follows:

3. Relatedly, Paragraph 70 of the Motion is amended to reflect that the expense reimbursement for each of the Stalking Horse Bidders does not exceed one percent (1%) of the cash purchase price, except with respect to the ECM Stalking Horse Bidder which is approximately one-and-a-quarter percent (1.25%) of the cash purchase price.
