**ORDER SUSTAINING WIND DOWN DEBTOR’S OBJECTION TO  
CLAIM NO. 120 FILED BY RICHARD OUTRAM**

Upon the *Debtor’s Objection to Claim No. 120 filed by Richard Outram*, dated October 8, 2025 [Docket No. 749] (as amended on October 9, 2025 at Docket No. 751, the “Objection”)<sup>1</sup>, for entry of an order (this “Order”) reclassifying Claim No. 120; and the Court having jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and the matter being a core proceeding within the meaning of 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); and venue of this proceeding and the Objection in this District being proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and the Court having scheduled

an initial hearing on the Objection for November 20, 2025, at 2:30 p.m. (prevailing Eastern Time); and the hearing on the Objection having been adjourned to January 13, 2026, at 1:30 p.m. (prevailing Eastern Time) (the “Hearing”); and due and sufficient notice of the Objection and (i) the opportunity to respond or object to the relief requested in the Objection by December 22, 2025 at 4:00 p.m. (prevailing Eastern Time) (the “Response Deadline”) and (ii) the proposed Hearing on the Objection, in the event a response or objection is filed by the Response Deadline, scheduled for January 13, 2026, at 1:30 p.m. (prevailing Eastern Time), having been provided in accordance with the Fifth Amended and Restated General Order No. 24-2018; and no objection or response to the Objection having been filed prior to the Response Deadline; and based on the foregoing, no further notice or hearing is required and the Court finds that good cause exists to grant the relief requested in the Objection; and the Court having considered the Objection and all other matters of record, including the lack of response or objection thereto, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. The Objection is SUSTAINED, as set forth herein.
2. Claim No. 120 filed by Richard Outram is reclassified in its entirety as a general unsecured claim.
3. Nothing set forth in this Order shall be construed as, or shall in any way constitute, a waiver of the Wind Down Debtor’s or any successor’s rights to assert objections to the Claim No. 120 on any additional grounds whatsoever.
4. Wind Down Debtor’s counsel will promptly cause a copy of this Order to be served on the parties listed on the Wind Down Debtor’s Limited Service List for this chapter 11 case and any parties that were served with the Objection. Wind Down Debtor’s counsel shall cause a Certificate of Service evidencing such service to be filed within three days of service.

5. The Wind Down Debtor and its claims and noticing agent, Kurtzman Carson Consultants, LLC d/b/a Verita, as well as the Clerk of the Court, are authorized to take all such actions as are necessary and appropriate to effectuate the terms of this Order.

6. This Court shall retain jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation, interpretation, or enforcement of this Order.
