EX PARTE MOTION FOR ORDER SHORTENING NOTICE

The United States Bankruptcy Administrator for the Western District of North Carolina (“Bankruptcy Administrator”) by this Ex Parte Motion respectfully requests the entry of an Order shortening the prescribed notice of the *Motion to Modify Oder Establishing Mediation Protocol* (the “Substantive Motion”). In support of this Motion to Shorten Notice, the Bankruptcy Administrator respectfully represents and says:

1. The Bankruptcy Administrator requests that this Court shorten the notice period, pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 9006, so that the Court can hear the Substantive Motion on Thursday, November 20, 2025, at 9:30 a.m.
2. In advance of filing, the Bankruptcy Administrator communicated to the Debtors, ACC, and the FCR that she intended to file the Substantive Motion.
3. The Bankruptcy Administrator submits that the shortened notice will prejudice no parties in interest, as the relief requested relates to mediation and only seeks a modification of previously granted relief.
