ORDER GRANTING FIFTEENTH INTERIM APPLICATION FOR ALLOWANCE OF COMPENSATION FOR SERVICES RENDERED AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES OF GILBERT LLP, SPECIAL INSURANCE COUNSEL TO THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF ASBESTOS PERSONAL INJURY CLAIMANTS, FOR THE PERIOD JUNE 1, 2025 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2025

This matter coming before the Court on the Fifteenth Interim Application for Allowance of Compensation for Services Rendered and Reimbursement of Expenses of Gilbert LLP, Special Insurance Counsel to the Official Committee of Asbestos Personal Injury Claimants, for the Period June 1, 2025 through September 30, 2025 [Doc. 2910] (the "Fifteenth Interim Application")² filed by Gilbert LLP ("Gilbert"), special insurance counsel to the Official Committee of Asbestos Personal Injury Claimants (the "Committee"); the Court having reviewed the Fifteenth Interim

Application; the Court having found that: (a) the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157 and 1334; (b) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b); (c) notice of the Fifteenth Interim Application was sufficient pursuant to Local Rule 2002-1(g) and the *Order Establishing Procedures for Interim Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses of Retained Professionals* [Docket No. 171] (the "Interim Compensation Order") and no other or further notice is required; (d) the compensation requested in the Fifteenth Interim Application is reasonable and for actual and necessary services rendered by Gilbert on behalf of the Committee during the period of June 1, 2025 through September 30, 2025 (the "Application Period"); (e) the expenses for which reimbursement is sought in the Fifteenth Interim Application are actual and necessary expenses incurred by Gilbert during the Application Period on behalf of the Committee; and (f) the Fifteenth Interim Application fully complies with the Interim Compensation Order, the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules, the Local Rules, and the Guidelines; and the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Fifteenth Interim Application establish just cause for the relief granted herein:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECREED THAT:

- 1. The Fifteenth Interim Application is GRANTED.
- 2. Gilbert is awarded, on an interim basis, compensation for professional services rendered during the Application Period in the amount of \$9,962.50 and reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred by Gilbert during the Application Period in the amount of \$0.00.
- 3. The Debtors are authorized and directed to pay Gilbert promptly the fees and expenses approved in this Order to the extent such amounts have not been paid previously by the Debtors.
