**SIXTH INTERIM FEE APPLICATION OF
VERUS, LLC AS PIQ DATA ADMINISTRATOR TO THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE
OF ASBESTOS PERSONAL INJURY CLAIMANTS FOR PAYMENT OF INTERIM
COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES INCURRED FOR THE
PERIOD FEBRUARY 1, 2025 THROUGH MAY 31, 2025**

Verus, LLC (“Verus”), PIQ Data Administrator to the Official Committee of Asbestos Personal Injury Claimants (the “Committee”) of Aldrich Pump LLC, *et al.*, (the “Debtors”), hereby submits its Sixth Interim fee application (the “Sixth Interim Fee Application”) for allowance of compensation for professional services rendered and reimbursement of actual and necessary expenses incurred for the period February 1, 2025 through May 31, 2025.

INTRODUCTION

1. On June 18, 2020 (the “Petition Date”), the Debtors commenced this proceeding (the “Chapter 11 Case”) by filing a voluntary petition for relief under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code, 11 U.S.C. §§ 101 *et seq.* (the “Bankruptcy Code”).

2. Pursuant to sections 1107(a) and 1108 of the Bankruptcy Code, the Debtors have continued as a debtor-in-possession since the Petition Date. No trustee or examiner has been appointed in the Chapter 11 Case.

3. On June 30, 2020, the Bankruptcy Administrator moved for the appointment of the Official Committee of Asbestos Personal Injury Claimants in the Debtors' case pursuant section 1102 of the Bankruptcy Code [Dkt. No. 126]. The Bankruptcy Court orally granted the motion at a hearing on July 6, 2020 and entered an order memorializing its ruling on July 7, 2020. *See* [Dkt. No. 147].

4. On July 15, 2020, the Court entered the *Order Establishing Procedures for Interim Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses of Retained Professionals* [Dkt. No. 171] (the "Interim Fee Order"). Pursuant to the Interim Fee Order, the Court established a procedure for interim compensation and reimbursement of disbursements for professionals appointed in this case. In particular, the Court authorized the service to certain notice parties of monthly fee statements by professionals appointed in this case (including professionals employed by the Committee) and payment by the Debtors of 90% of fees and 100% of expenses, in the absence of an objection made within fourteen (14) days of service of the pertinent fee statement.

5. On March 8, 2023 the Committee filed the *Ex Parte Application of the Official Committee of Asbestos Personal Injury Claimants to Retain and Employ Verus, LLC as PIQ Data Administrator for the Personal Injury Questionnaire Responses* [Dkt. No. 1636].

6. On May 15, 2023, the Court entered its *Order Approving the Ex Parte Application of the Official Committee of Asbestos Personal Injury Claimants to Retain and Employ Verus, LLC as PIQ Data Administrator for the Personal Injury Questionnaire Responses* [Dkt. No. 1755].

RETENTION OF VERUS

7. The Committee retained Verus as PIQ Data Administrator in the Chapter 11 Case. By order dated May 15, 2023, Verus was appointed as PIQ Data Administrator for the Committee,

to perform certain tasks set forth in greater detail in the underlying retention application, effective as of May 15, 2023. *See* [Dkt. No. 1755].

8. As set forth in the in the application to retain Verus, Verus was engaged to perform the following services:

a. Download PIQ submissions from the Donlin Portal, and link submission data to the respective PIQ IDs based upon Donlin Master Service List PIQ IDs decoded and provided by LAS.

b. Create and maintain a machine-readable inventory of the documents included for each submission using LAS document type codes and perform ongoing 10% quality control (“QC”) on the document type coding.

c. Periodically account for and report on missing cases and duplicate cases against the master PIQ Service List.

d. Design and enter PIQ data into an online data entry platform (the “PIQ Data Capture System”) mirroring the PIQ and providing for capture of additional information from supporting documents as required.

e. Produce periodic data exports of items (a)-(d) during the PIQ data capture process.

f. Extract from the documents submitted with PIQs the key data related to disease, e.g., meso diagnosis date, other disease(s) present; exposure, e.g., work history, identification of Debtors’ and other products; defendants named and court cases filed; and trust filings, and include the source document for each data element extracted (capturing the data in a template similar to the PIQ data) and perform ongoing 10-20% QC on coding and data entry.

g. Provide LAS with access to the online PIQ Data Capture System.

h. Provide regular reports to LAS on productivity and schedule regular conference calls to discuss operations, troubleshoot and document problems and their resolutions, and answer questions about how to interpret the data.

i. Provide such other data processing and analysis tasks as may be requested by the Committee or LAS.

VERUS’S FEE STATEMENTS DURING THE FEE PERIOD

9. During the period covered by the Sixth Interim Fee Application (the “Fee Period”), Verus provided the Notice Parties with monthly fee statements in accordance with the Interim Fee

Order and the Guidelines for Compensation (the “Compensation Guidelines”). Thereafter, Verus submitted revised monthly fee statements during the Fee Period intended to provide additional detail in time entries and capture certain previously missing time entries and replaced the original statements.

10. The Debtors objected to the February and March monthly fee statements. The parties have spent a substantial amount of time working to resolve the Debtors’ objection. Pursuant to an agreement between Verus and the Debtors, Verus prepared the following revised statements for the Fee Period. All issues between Verus and the Debtors related to fees and expenses incurred by Verus to and including the Fee Period have been resolved and the Debtors consent to the allowance of such fees and expenses

- (a) For February 1, 2025 through February 28, 2025 – fees of \$99,525.00 and expenses of \$143,956.88 (the “February Monthly Fee Statement”). A copy of the February Monthly Fee Statement is attached hereto as Schedule A-1.
- (b) For March 1, 2025 through March 31, 2025 – fees of \$66,329.50 and expenses of \$88,544.95 (the “March Monthly Fee Statement”). A copy of the March Monthly Fee Statement is attached hereto as Schedule A-2.
- (c) No fees or expenses were incurred for April 1, 2025 – May 31, 2025.

11. In total, Verus submitted monthly fee statements during the Fee Period for fees of \$165,854.50 and expenses of \$232,501.83. A chart summarizing the monthly statements submitted during this Fee Period is below:

SUMMARY OF SERVICES

12. The professional services performed by Verus were necessary and appropriate to the administration of the Debtors' chapter 11 cases. These services were in the best interests of the Debtors, the estates, and creditors. The compensation requested is commensurate with the complexity and nature of the issues and tasks involved.

PROGRESS OF THE CHAPTER 11 CASE TO DATE

13. Since its engagement in these cases, Verus has downloaded PIQ submissions, including supporting documentation; begun the design and construction of the online data entry and capture platform; begun review and extraction of PIQ data; and commenced detailed review of supporting documentation. In addition, Verus has conducted regular conference calls with LAS regarding operations and progress to date.

14. Verus has not previously applied for payment of any fees or reimbursement of any disbursement during this Chapter 11 Case except as authorized pursuant to the Interim Fee Order, including monthly submissions of fee statements. Verus does not hold a retainer in respect of its services as PIQ Data Administrator for the Committee.

LEGAL BASIS FOR REQUESTED RELIEF

15. Section 331 of the Bankruptcy Code provides for interim compensation of professionals and incorporates the substantive standards of section 330 of the Bankruptcy Code to govern the Court's award of such compensation. Section 330 of the Bankruptcy Code provides that a court may award a professional employed under section 1103 of the Bankruptcy Code "reasonable compensation for actual, necessary services rendered . . . and . . . reimbursement for actual, necessary expenses." 11 U.S.C. § 330(a)(1)(A) and (B).

16. Section 330 of the Bankruptcy Code also sets forth the criteria for the award of such compensation and reimbursement:

In determining the amount of reasonable compensation to be awarded to . . . [a] professional person, the court shall consider the nature, the extent, and the value of such services, taking into account all relevant factors, including --

- (A) the time spent on such services;
- (B) the rates charged for such services;
- (C) whether the services were necessary to the administration of, or beneficial at the time at which the service was rendered toward the completion of, a case under this title;
- (D) whether the services were performed within a reasonable amount of time commensurate with the complexity, importance, and nature of the problem, issue, or task addressed;
- (E) with respect to a professional person, whether the person is board certified or otherwise has demonstrated skill and experience in the bankruptcy field; and
- (F) whether the compensation is reasonable based on the customary compensation charged by comparably skilled practitioners in cases other than cases under this title.

11 U.S.C. § 330(a)(3)(A)-(F).

17. The foregoing professional services performed by Verus were appropriate and necessary to the effective administration of the Chapter 11 Case. The services were in the best interests of the Committee. Compensation for the foregoing services as requested is commensurate with the complexity, importance, and nature of the problems, as well as issues or tasks involved. The professional services were performed in an appropriately expeditious and efficient manner.

18. In accordance with section 504 of the Bankruptcy Code and Fed. R. Bankr. P. 2016(a), no agreement or understanding exists between Verus and any other person for the sharing of compensation received or to be received for services rendered in or in connection with this case.

19. No agreement or understanding prohibited by 18 U.S.C. § 155 has been or will be made by Verus.

THE REQUESTED COMPENSATION SHOULD BE ALLOWED

20. The services for which Verus seeks compensation in this Sixth Interim Fee Application were, at the time rendered, necessary for, beneficial to, and in the best interests of, the Committee and the Debtors' estates. The services rendered by Verus were consistently performed in a timely manner commensurate with the complexity, importance, and nature of the issues involved. In accordance with the factors enumerated in section 330 of the Bankruptcy Code, it is respectfully submitted that the amount requested by Verus is fair and reasonable given (a) the complexity of this case, (b) the time expended, (c) the nature and extent of the services rendered, (d) the value of such services, and (e) the costs of comparable services other than in a case under this title.

NO PRIOR REQUEST

21. No prior request for the relief sought in this Sixth Interim Fee Application has been made to this or any other court in connection with the Chapter 11 Case apart from the delivery of the monthly fee statements.

NOTICE

22. Notice of this Sixth Interim Fee Application has been provided in accordance with the Interim Fee Order. Verus submits that no other or further notice need be provided.

CONCLUSION

WHEREFORE, Verus respectfully requests that the Court: (i) enter the order attached as Exhibit A granting the Sixth Interim Fee Application and authorizing interim allowance of compensation in the amount of \$165,854.50 for professional services rendered on behalf of the

Official Committee of Asbestos Personal Injury Claimants of and reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses in the amount of \$232,501.83; (ii) direct payment by the Debtors of the foregoing amounts less any amount already paid pursuant to the Interim Fee Order; and (iii) grant such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper.

Court, noting the agreement and consent of the Debtors, having found that: (a) the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; (b) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b); (c) notice of the Sixth Interim Fee Application was sufficient pursuant to Local Rule 2002-1(g) and the *Order Establishing Procedures for Interim Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses of Retained Professionals* [Dkt. No. 171] (the “Interim Fee Order”) and no other or further notice is required; (d) the compensation requested in the Sixth Interim Fee Application is reasonable and for actual and necessary services rendered by Verus on behalf of the Committee during the period of February 1, 2025 through May 31, 2025 (the “Fee Period”); (e) the expenses for which reimbursement is sought in the Sixth Interim Fee Application are actual and necessary expenses incurred by Verus during the Fee Period on behalf of the Committee; and (f) the Sixth Interim Fee Application fully complies with the Interim Fee Order, the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules, the Local Rules, and the Guidelines; and the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Sixth Interim Fee Application establish just cause for the relief granted herein:

1. The Sixth Interim Fee Application is GRANTED.

3. Within five business days of the date of this Order, the Debtors are authorized and directed to pay Verus promptly the fees and expenses approved in this Order to the extent such amounts have not been paid previously by the Debtors.
4. The Debtors and Verus are authorized and empowered to take all actions necessary to implement the relief granted in this Order.

5. This Court shall retain jurisdiction over any and all matters arising from or related to the implementation, enforcement, or interpretation of this Order.
