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ORDER GRANTING THE SIXTH INTERIM FEE APPLICATION OF VERUS, LLC, AS PIQ DATA ADMINISTRATOR TO THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF ASBESTOS PERSONAL INJURY CLAIMANTS FOR PAYMENT OF INTERIM COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES INCURRED FOR THE PERIOD FEBRUARY 1, 2025 THROUGH MAY 31, 2025

This matter coming before the Court on the *Sixth Interim Fee Application of Verus, LLC as PIQ Data Administrator to the Official Committee of Asbestos Personal Injury Claimants for Payment of Interim Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses Incurred for the Period February 1, 2025 through May 31, 2025* (the “Sixth Interim Fee Application”) filed by Verus, LLC (“Verus”), PIQ data administrator to the Official Committee of Asbestos Personal Injury Claimants (the “Committee”); the Court having reviewed the Sixth Interim Fee Application; the

Court, noting the agreement and consent of the Debtors, having found that: (a) the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; (b) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b); (c) notice of the Sixth Interim Fee Application was sufficient pursuant to Local Rule 2002-1(g) and the *Order Establishing Procedures for Interim Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses of Retained Professionals* [Dkt. No. 171] (the “Interim Fee Order”) and no other or further notice is required; (d) the compensation requested in the Sixth Interim Fee Application is reasonable and for actual and necessary services rendered by Verus on behalf of the Committee during the period of February 1, 2025 through May 31, 2025 (the “Fee Period”); (e) the expenses for which reimbursement is sought in the Sixth Interim Fee Application are actual and necessary expenses incurred by Verus during the Fee Period on behalf of the Committee; and (f) the Sixth Interim Fee Application fully complies with the Interim Fee Order, the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules, the Local Rules, and the Guidelines; and the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Sixth Interim Fee Application establish just cause for the relief granted herein:

The Sixth Interim Fee Application is GRANTED.

Verus is awarded, on an interim basis, compensation for professional services rendered during the Fee Period in the amount of \$165,854.50 and reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred by Verus during the Fee Period in the amount of \$232,501.83.

Within five business days of the date of this Order, the Debtors are authorized and directed to pay Verus promptly the fees and expenses approved in this Order to the extent such amounts have not been paid previously by the Debtors.

The Debtors and Verus are authorized and empowered to take all actions necessary to implement the relief granted in this Order.

This Court shall retain jurisdiction over any and all matters arising from or related to the implementation, enforcement, or interpretation of this Order.
