NOTICE OF HYBRID HEARING

On February 14, 2023, the above-referenced debtors and debtors in possession (the “Debtors”) commenced these chapter 11 cases.

In accordance with Sections H of the *Procedures for Complex Chapter 11 Cases in the Southern District of Texas* (the “Complex Case Procedures”), a hybrid hearing is set for **March 7, 2023 at 3:00 p.m. (prevailing Central Time)** before Judge Jones of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Texas – Houston Division (the “Court”) to consider the following motion:

- **DIP Motion.** Debtors’ Emergency Motion for Entry of Final Order (I) Authorizing the Debtors to (A) Obtain Postpetition Financing and (B) Utilize Cash Collateral, (II) Granting Liens and Superpriority Administrative Expense Claims, (III) Granting Adequate Protection to the Prepetition Secured Parties, (IV) Modifying the Automatic Stay, and (V) Granting Related Relief [Docket No. 47].

You may participate in the hearing either in person or by an audio and video connection. Audio communication will be by the use of the Court’s dial-in facility. You may access the facility at **(832) 917-1510**. Once connected, you will be asked to enter the conference room number. Judge Jones’ conference room number is **205691**. Video communication will be by use of the GoToMeeting platform. Connect via the free GoToMeeting application or click the link on Judge Jones’ homepage. The meeting code is “judgejones.” Click the settings icon in the upper right corner and enter your name under the personal information setting.
