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TO THE HONORABLE SANDRA KLEIN, UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY JUDGE, THE DEBTORS, AND ALL OTHER PARTIES ENTITLED TO NOTICE:

The stipulation (the "Stipulation") is entered into by and between Howard M. Ehrenberg, in his capacity as chapter 11 trustee in the above-captioned chapter 11 cases (the "Trustee"), U.S. Bank Trust Company, National Association, as Master Trustee ("Master Trustee"), Triple P RTS, LLC and Triple P Securities, LLC (collectively, "TPS"); Sheppard Mullin Richter & Hampton, LLP ("SMRH"), Dentons US LLP ("Dentons"), Sills Cummis & Gross PC ("Sills"), Province, LLC ("Province"), *Orrick, Herrington & Sutcliffe LLP ("Orrick"), and Colliers International Greater Los Angeles ("Collier").* In support of this Stipulation, the Parties refer to the following recitals:

RECITALS

- A. WHEREAS on September 6, 2023, the above-captioned debtors (collectively, the "Debtors") filed three (3) interim fee applications requesting that the Court allow and award compensation and reimbursement of expenses, on an interim basis, to the Debtors' general bankruptcy counsel, SMRH, their special and conflicts counsel, Orrick, and their restructuring advisor, Triple P RTS, under section 331 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code").
- B. WHEREAS on September 6, 2023, the Debtors' real estate broker, Colliers, filed an interim fee application requesting that that the Court allow and award

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compensation and reimbursement of expenses to Colliers, on an interim basis, under

section 331 of the Bankruptcy Code (the interim fee applications filed by Sheppard Mullin,

Orrick, Triple P RTS, and Colliers, collectively, the "Debtors' Professionals Applications").

- C. WHEREAS on September 6, 2023, the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (the "Committee") in the above-captioned chapter 11 case of debtor Beverly Community Hospital Association ("Beverly" or the "Debtor") filed three (3) interim fee applications (collectively, the "Committee's Professionals Applications," and together with the Debtors' Professionals Applications, the "Fee Applications") requesting that the Court allow and award compensation and reimbursement of expenses, on an interim basis, to the Committee's co-counsels, Dentons and Sills Cummis, and its financial advisor, Province, under section 331 of the Bankruptcy Code.
- D. WHEREAS, on September 13, 2023, the Court entered the Order Directing the Appointment of a Chapter 11 Trustee and Setting Hearing and Briefing Schedule on Fee Applications [Docket No. 803] (the "Scheduling Order").
- E. WHEREAS, pursuant to the Scheduling Order, the hearings on the Fee Applications were continued to January 10, 2024 at 9:00 a.m., with oppositions to the applications due November 22, 2023 and replies, if any, due December 13, 2023.
- F. WHEREAS, on September 15, 2023, the United States Trustee filed the Notice of Appointment of a Chapter 11 Trustee [Docket No. 811] appointing Howard M. Ehrenberg as the Trustee in these chapter 11 cases, which the Court approved [Docket No. 815].
- G. WHEREAS, on October 12, 2023, the Court entered the *Order Approving Stipulation re Debtors' Application to Retain and Employ Triple P Securities, LLC*, [Docket No. 841], setting a hearing on the Debtors' Notice of Application and Application Seeking an Order Authorizing the Retention and Employment of Triple P Securities, LLC as Investment Banker to the Debtors and Debtors in Possession Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 327(a) and 328 Effective as of April 19, 2023 [Docket No. 280] (the "TPS Application" and

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prevailing Pacific Time (the "Retention Hearing").

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H. WHEREAS, on October 30, 2023, the Court entered its "Order Assigning" Matter to Mediation Program and Appointing Mediator and Alternate Mediator" in the adversary proceeding filed by the Committee against the Master Lender (the "Committee" Adversary", Adversary Proceeding Number 2:23-ap-01289-SK).

together with the Fee Applications, the "Applications") for January 24, 2024, at 9:00 a.m.,

- Ι. WHEREAS, on November 9, 2023, the Court entered its "Order Approving Stipulation to Continue Hearing on Multiple Interim Fee Applications" [Docket no. 865], whereby the hearings on the Fee Applications were further continued to February 14, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. Objections to the Fee Applications are due on January 17, 2024, and replies to any objections are due on January 31, 2024.
- J. WHEREAS, it is currently contemplated that the mediation of the Committee Adversary Proceeding will take place in February, 2024. The Parties wish to further continue the hearings on the Fee Applications and the TPS Application to allow the mediation of the Committee Adversary Proceeding to take place, and to allow the Trustee's efforts to recover funds which may be available for the payment of professional fees to continue. The Parties believe that expending the time and expense related to reviewing and litigating any objections to the Fee Applications or the TPS Application would be wasteful of their and the Court's resources at this time.
- K. WHEREAS, TPS and the Master Trustee request that the Court nonetheless reserve the time previously set for the hearing on the TPS Application (January 24 at 9:00 a.m.) to hold a status conference on that application to address several disputes that have arisen between TPS and the Master Trustee regarding discovery matters and the hearing on the TPS Application and to address logistics regarding the hearing on the TPS Application.

ACCORDINGLY, AND SUBJECT TO THIS COURT'S APPROVAL, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED THAT:

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- Any objections to the Fee Applications (the "Objections") must be filed on or before March 27, 2024;
 - 2. Replies to Objections, if any, must be filed on or before April 24, 2024; and
- 3. The hearing on the Fee Applications and the TPS Application will be heard on May 8, 2024, at 10:00 a.m., or such other date and time convenient to the Court.
- 4. This Stipulation does not apply to the first and final fee application filed by Tamar Terzian, Patient Care Ombudsman ("PCO") filed on December 29, 2023 [Dkt No. 907].
- A status conference regarding the TPS Application will be held on January
 24, 2024 at 9:00 a.m. (Pacific Time).
