**(No Protest Notice: No Hearing Will Be Held
Unless Request For Hearing Is Filed)**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Creditor/Interested Party T&TG9, LLC (“Movant” or “Property Owner”) have filed the Motion for Entry of Order Confirming that Purchase and Sale Agreement is not an Executory Contract or, in the Alternative, Compelling Rejection of the Purchase and Sale Agreement and Granting Relief from the Automatic Stay [D.E. 80] (the “Motion”).

If a copy of the Motion is not included with this Notice of Hearing, a copy may be viewed at the Court’s website, www.ncwb.uscourts.gov, under the Debtor’s name and case number; at <https://www.veritaglobal.net/brd>, or you may request in writing a copy from the undersigned party.

YOUR RIGHTS MAY BE AFFECTED. YOU SHOULD READ THESE PAPERS CAREFULLY AND DISCUSS THEM WITH YOUR ATTORNEY, IF YOU HAVE ONE IN THIS BANKRUPTCY CASE. (IF YOU DO NOT HAVE AN ATTORNEY, YOU MAY WISH TO CONSULT ONE.)

IF YOU DO NOT WANT THE COURT TO GRANT THE RELIEF REQUESTED IN THE MOTIONS, OF IF YOU WANT THE COURT TO CONSIDER YOUR VIEWS ON THE MOTIONS, THEN ON OR BEFORE **APRIL 9, 2026, YOU MUST:**

- (1) A. File a written response or objection with the court requesting that the court hold a hearing and explaining your position. File the response at:

- B. If you have your attorney file a written objection then the objection should be filed with the Bankruptcy Court by electronic means through the Court's website, *www.ncwb.uscourts.gov* under the jointly administered name and case number shown above.
