B. Borrower's Default Under Loan Documents

Sycamore Meadows Apartments, LTD (the "<u>Debtor</u>") filed a petition for bankruptcy under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code on October 6, 2025 ("Petition Date").

Prior to the Petition Date, as a result of the defaults under the terms of the Loan Documents, as such defaults prior to the Petition Date, Fannie Mae, in compliance with Fannie Mae's remedies under applicable law and the terms of the Loan Documents, accelerated the balance due under the Loan Documents.
