Upon consideration of the interim fee applications [Docket Nos. 705, 708, 709, and 710] (the “Interim Fee Applications”) of certain retained professionals (collectively, the “Retained Professionals” and each a “Retained Professional”) for the periods covering September 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025, in the above-captioned debtor’s (the “Debtor”) chapter 11 case and listed on **Exhibit A** hereto filed in accordance with the *Administrative Fee Order Establishing Procedures for the Allowance and Payment of Interim Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses of Professionals Retained by Order of this Court* [Docket No. 178] (the “Interim Compensation Order”); and the Court having reviewed the Interim Fee Applications; and the Court finding that: (a) the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1334; (b) notice of the Interim Fee Applications and the hearing thereon was adequate under the circumstances; (c) all parties with notice of the Interim Fee Applications have been afforded the opportunity to be heard on the Interim Fee Applications; and (d) all of the requirements of 11 U.S.C. §§ 327, 328, 330, and 331, Rule 2016 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and Rules 2016-1 and 2016-3 of the Local Rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Jersey, have been satisfied; and after due deliberation and sufficient and good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:
