The time period within which the GUC Trustee may file objections to General Unsecured Claims is enlarged and extended through and including the later of: (a) January 5, 2026, or (b) one hundred eighty (180) days following the date that a proof of Claim asserting a General Unsecured Claim is filed or amended (the "Claims Objection Deadline").
- 3. This Order shall be without prejudice to the rights of the GUC Trustee to seek further extensions of the Claims Objection Deadline.
