SUPPLEMENT OF YOUNG CONAWAY STARGATT & TAYLOR, LLP TO DEBTORS' FIRST INTERIM FEE APPLICATION

Young Conaway Stargatt & Taylor, LLP ("Young Conaway" or the "Firm"), counsel to the debtors and debtors in possession in the above-captioned cases (collectively, the "**Debtors**"), hereby supplements the First Interim Fee Application of Young Conaway Stargatt & Taylor, LLP (the "First Interim Application") for the period from March 31, 2025 through and including June 30, 2025 (the "Application Period") by attaching, as Exhibits A through $\underline{\mathbf{E}}$ hereto, certain schedules requested by the Appendix B Guidelines for Reviewing Applications for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses Filed Under United States Code by Attorneys in Larger Chapter 11 Cases (the "UST Guidelines"). In addition, Young Conaway respectfully states as follows to address the questions set forth under section C.5 of the UST Guidelines:

- During the Application Period, Young Conaway did not agree to any variations a. from, or alternatives to, its standard or customary billing rates, fees, or terms.
- The fees sought by Young Conaway in the First Interim Application are not more b. than 10% higher than the fees budgeted for Young Conaway for the Application Period.

Due to the large number of Debtors in these chapter 11 cases a complete list of the Debtors is not provided herein. A complete list of the Debtors along with the last four digits of their tax identification numbers, where applicable, may be obtained on the website of the Debtors' noticing and claims agent at https://veritaglobal.net/dolphinco, or by contacting counsel for the Debtors. - c. The professionals included in the First Interim Application did not vary their hourly rates based on the geographic location of the bankruptcy cases.
- d. The First Interim Application did not include any fees dedicated to revising time records or preparing and revising invoices that would not normally be compensable outside of bankruptcy.
- e. The time period covered by the First Interim Application includes approximately 2.00 hours with a value of \$2,170.00 spent by Young Conaway to ensure that the time entries subject to the First Interim Application comply with the Local Rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware and do not disclose privileged or confidential information. This review, and any revisions associated therewith, are a necessary component of Young Conaway's preparation of each monthly fee application.
- f. The First Interim Application did not include any rate increases since the effective date of the Court's approval of Young Conaway's retention.
