**ORDER GRANTING SECOND INTERIM APPLICATION
OF RAINES FELDMAN LITRELL LLP FOR COMPENSATION
FOR SERVICES RENDERED AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES,
AS CO-COUNSEL FOR THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED
CREDITORS FOR THE PERIOD OCTOBER 1, 2025 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2025**

Raines Feldman Littrell LLP (“Raines”), as co-counsel for the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (the “Committee”) in the above captioned cases, filed its Second Interim Application for Compensation for Services Rendered and Reimbursement of Expenses for the Period from October 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025 (the “Interim Fee Application”). The Court has reviewed the Interim Fee Application and finds that: (a) the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; (b) notice of the Interim Fee Application, and any hearing on the Interim Fee Application, was adequate under the circumstances; and (c) all persons with standing have been afforded the opportunity to be heard on the Interim Fee Application. Accordingly, it is hereby,

ORDERED that the Interim Fee Application is GRANTED, on an interim basis. The Debtor in the above-captioned cases shall pay to Raines the sum of \$55,662.00 as compensation for necessary

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professional services rendered, and actual and necessary expenses in the amount of \$160.60 for a total of \$55,822.60 for services rendered and disbursements incurred by Raines for the period October 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025, less any amounts previously paid in connection with the monthly fee applications.

ORDERED that this Court retains jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation, interpretation, and enforcement of this Order.
