**NOTICE OF INCREASED ORDINARY COURSE PROFESSIONAL
CAP AMOUNT WITH RESPECT TO DE LA VEGA & MARTINEZ ROJAS**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that, on May 1, 2025, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the “**Court**”) entered the *Order (I) Authorizing the Debtors to Retain and Compensate Professionals Utilized in the Ordinary Course of Business and (II) Granting Related Relief* [Docket No. 114] (the “**OCP Order**”).²

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, on June 26, 2025, the Debtors filed the *Notice of Filing of Third Supplement to List of Ordinary Course Professionals* [Docket No. 256] (the “**Third Supplemental OCP List**”), to which no objection was received. Pursuant to the OCP Order and the Third Supplemental OCP List, the Debtors were authorized to pay De la Vega & Martinez Rojas (“**De la Vega**”) up to \$15,000 per month, calculated over the prior rolling three-month period (the “**OCP Cap**”).

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, since the Debtors filed the Third OCP Supplement, the scope of De la Vega's work as labor counsel in Mexico has expanded to include certain litigation and other matters. Therefore, to accommodate De la Vega's expanded role, the Debtors seek to adjust the OCP Cap for De la Vega to \$50,000 per month, calculated over the prior rolling three-month period.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that any responses or objections to the increased OCP Cap must be in writing, filed with the Court, 3rd Floor, 824 North Market Street, Wilmington, Delaware 19801, and served upon the Debtors' undersigned counsel on or before **4:00 p.m. (ET) on February 6, 2026.**
