**NOTICE OF HEARING**

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that, a hearing (the “Hearing”) will be held before the Honorable John P. Mastando III, United States Bankruptcy Judge for the Southern District of New York, (the “Court”), in Courtroom No. 501, One Bowling Green, New York, New York 10004, on **August 20, 2025, at 9:00 a.m. (Eastern Time)** on the following matter:

Apargo Limited, Fentalon Limited, and Desimusco Trading Limited (collectively the “Preferred Shareholders”) motion for an Order, pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9016, Fed. R. Civ. P. 45 and this Court’s Order of June 16, 2025, providing the Preferred Shareholders “an opportunity to object in writing to the subpoena or to file any written motion with the Court” quashing Eletson Holdings, Inc.’s Rule 2004 Subpoenas directed against the Preferred Shareholders and granting a protective order against the requested depositions, and for such other and further relief as the Court deems just.

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that opposition to the Motion must be filed on or before **August 13, 2025**, and replies, if any, must be received no later than **August 17, 2025**.

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that the that the hearing shall be held via Zoom for Government. Parties wishing to appear at the hearing, whether making a “live” or “listen only”
