As ordered by this Court, we write on behalf of Provisional Eletson Holdings Inc. (“Provisional Holdings”) regarding the *Application for Attorneys’ Fees and Costs* (Dkt. 1729) and supporting declarations (Dkt. 1730, 1731, 1732) (the “Application”) filed by Reorganized Holdings Inc. (“Reorganized Holdings”) between 11:15 p.m. and 12:06 a.m. last night and to request a brief, eight-day extension of the July 23, 2025 deadline to respond to the Application (*see* Dkt. 1712 ¶ 2), to July 31, 2025. There is no hearing date currently scheduled for the Application (*see id.*).
