How are you?

We are Shanghai Xundao New Energy Technology Co., Ltd., the Creditor of "Fisker Group Inc." (Debtor Case Number: 24-11377, Claim #: 3791.)

We have received a notification email regarding "Liquidating Trustee's Eleventh Omnibus Objection (Non-Substantive) Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 502, Fed. R. Bankr. P. 3007 and Local Rule 3007-1 to Certain Late-Filed Claims [Hearing scheduled for 9/3/2025 at 11:00 AM at US Bankruptcy Court, 824 Market St., 5th Fl., Courtroom #5, Wilmington, Delaware. Objections due by 8/22/2025.] [Docket No. 1097]", it mentioned that our claim has been objected due to the late submission regarding our claim.

We **DISAGREE** with the objection to our Claim. The following is a further clarification regarding this issue.

We submitted our claim after the deadline was because we received the paper documents very late. We submitted our claim immediately after receiving them, but still missed the deadline. This delay was caused by the fact that we never received any effective advance notice (such as an email) from the Bankruptcy case administrator.

Therefore, we were unaware that these paper documents had been mailed to us.

In addition, for international delivery, shipping and customs clearance inherently take longer. Because we were unaware of the existence of these documents, they were held at the security office at the industrial park for some date.

If the Bankruptcy case administrator had provided us with any form of notice (such as an email) when the paper documents were mailed, we would have followed up on the delivery progress and processed them promptly. We also did not receive any email from the bankruptcy administrator regarding the filing of the claim and the corresponding deadline.

Furthermore, because this case involves creditors outside the United States, we believe it is very **UNREASONABLE** to set the same deadline for both non-US creditors and US creditors. The Bankruptcy case administrator should have taken this time difference into



account when setting the deadline and the paper documents were mailed.

P.S.: Attached is the date stamp on the back of the envelope containing the paper documents we received from the United States (this date stamp "2024.09.05.09" indicates the actual delivery date to the security office at the industrial park where our company is located). But because we were unaware of the existence of these documents, they were held at the security office at the industrial park for some date. This is why we did not submit our claim by the required deadline.

We sincerely hope that this case can be handled and treated fairly and justly.
