their estates may file notices of removal of claims and causes of action is hereby extended through

and including September 15, 2025 (the "Removal Deadline").

3. This Order shall be without prejudice to (a) the rights of the Debtors to seek further

extensions of the Removal Deadline, and (b) any position the Debtors may take regarding whether

section 362 of the Bankruptcy Code applies to stay any Action.

4. The Debtors are authorized to take all actions necessary to effectuate the relief

granted pursuant to this Order in accordance with the Motion.

This Court retains jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to 5.

the implementation, interpretation, and enforcement of this Order.
