Dear Mr. Cayce:

In its response to Appellants' petition for a rehearing en banc, Highland referred the Court to a recent report (the "Report") issued by Judge Jernigan in the *Acis* case in which she recommended that certain claims asserted against Dondero be dismissed with prejudice thereby shielding him from substantial personal liability. *Appellee's Response to Petition for Rehearing En Banc*, Document 117 at 10 n.29 (citing Document No. 75).

After the District Court adopted Judge Jernigan's Report, Acis objected and moved for reconsideration and related relief. Yesterday, Chief Judge Godbey of the District Court issued an Order that, after considering the merits of Acis' objection, again adopted Judge Jernigan's Report and dismissed with prejudice certain claims asserted against Dondero. *Acis Cap. Mgmt., L.P. v. Dondero*, 3:24-cv-02036-N, Document No. 13.

The District Court's continued adoption and adherence to Judge Jernigan's Report cannot be reconciled with Appellants' contention that Judge Jernigan is biased against Dondero and his affiliates.
