As set forth in the undersigned's Judge Specific Requirements, "Judge Kinkeade does not permit parties to stipulate to extend any deadline under the Scheduling Order or any time specified by the Federal Rules in which an act must be done. The parties shall request an extension of time by formal motion under the applicable standard."Because this is the first such request, the Court will generously construe the Stipulation as a motion for extension of time. Upon careful consideration of the Stipulation, the Court finds the requested extension of time is justified. Accordingly, the Court <b>GRANTS</b> the requested relief. Appellant shall file the Designation of Record and Statement of the Issues <b>by August 11, 2025</b>.Any further requests for extensions of time under the federal rules or modifications of court-ordered deadlines shall be made by formal motion to the Court.
