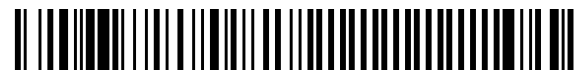
**ORDER GRANTING FINAL FEE APPLICATION OF PROVINCE, LLC
