3. Within two (2) business days after the lapse in appropriations is resolved, the United States Trustee shall file a notice on the docket so stating. Within seven (7) business days after the lapse in appropriations is resolved, the United States Trustee must either 1) file a stipulation that sets a new briefing schedule for the fee applications and proposes a new hearing date or, if an agreement is not reached 2) file a request that the Court set a new briefing schedule and hearing date.
