**ORDER ON THE MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES TRUSTEE FOR A  
STAY OF FEE HEARINGS IN LIGHT OF LAPSE OF APPROPRIATIONS**

The Acting United States Trustee (the “United States Trustee”) filed her Motion of the United States Trustee for a Stay of the hearing set for December 5, 2025 and associated briefing schedules on fee applications for compensation in light of the lapse of appropriations (“Motion”).

Based on the Motion and for good cause,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion is Granted.
2. The hearing set for December 5, 2025 on fee applications for compensation is off calendar. Once the lapse in appropriations is resolved, the Court will reschedule the hearing.



1 3. Within two (2) business days after the lapse in appropriations is resolved, the United  
2 States Trustee shall file a notice on the docket so stating. Within seven (7) business  
3 days after the lapse in appropriations is resolved, the United States Trustee must  
4 either 1) file a stipulation that sets a new briefing schedule for the fee applications  
5 and proposes a new hearing date or, if an agreement is not reached 2) file a request  
6 that the Court set a new briefing schedule and hearing date.
