Carroll, Acting United States Trustee for Region 15 ("United States 20 21 Trustee"), by and through her undersigned counsel, hereby files this Notice of Voluntary 22 Reduction in Fees with Respect to ArentFox Schiff LLP's Second Interim Fee 23 Application (the "Applicant" and "Application"), filed in the above-captioned case. 24 In support, the United States Trustee respectfully represents as follows: 25 26 1. The fee applicant bears the burden of proof to show entitlement to the 27 1 28



requested fees under 11 U.S.C. § 330. *See In re Eliapo*, 298 B.R. 392, 402 (B.A.P. 9th Cir. 2003), *rev'd in part on other grounds*, 468 F.3d 592 (9th Cir. 2006); *In re Ginji Corp.*, 117 B.R. 983, 990 (Bankr. D. Nev. 1990) ("[t]he applicant ... has the burden of proof to show the reasonableness of the fees sought").

- 2. Interim fee awards are always subject to reexamination during a bankruptcy case. *See In re Strand*, 375 F.3d 854, 858 (9th Cir. 2004).
- 3. The United States Trustee has reached an agreement with the Applicant to resolve the United States Trustee's informal opposition to the Application.
- 4. Applicant has consented to a voluntary reduction of \$5,362.50 in legal fees to address, in the United States Trustee's view, transitory timekeeping, administrative/overhead tasks, vague entries, block billing, and excessive hearing attendance.
- 5. After accounting for Applicant's voluntary reduction, the Application now requests a total of \$420,798 in legal fees and reimbursement of expenses in the amount of \$1,185.304. *See* Dkt. No. 485.
