

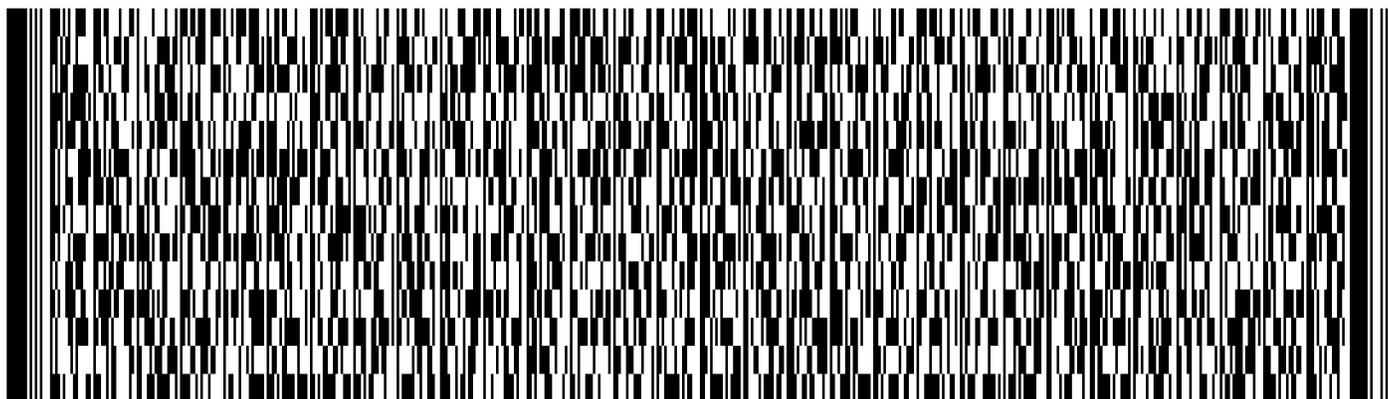
Bankruptcy Table 1-50




Bankruptcy Table 51-100

**Notes to the Post Confirmation Report for the Lead Case**

**General Notes**

On June 2, 2024 (the "Petition Date"), LaVie Care Centers and the 281 other Debtor entities (combined the "Debtors") filed for protection under Chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code") in the Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Georgia, Atlanta Division (the "Bankruptcy Court").

The Debtors' *Amended Joint Chapter 11 Combined Plan and Disclosure Statement* ("Plan and Disclosure Statement") was confirmed by the Bankruptcy Court on December 5, 2024 [D.I. 735]. On June 1, 2025 ("Effective Date"), the Plan became Effective (as defined in the Plan and Disclosure Statement) and Ryniker Consultants LLC became the GUC Trustee of the LaVie Care Centers GUC Trust (the "Trust").

The Court established the following key Bar Dates for filing proofs of claim against the Debtors' estates:

- August 30, 2024 - General Bar Date
- November 29, 2024 - Governmental Bar Date
- July 1, 2025 - Rejection Damages Bar Date and Administrative Claims Bar Date

On August 28, 2025, the Bankruptcy Court entered the *Order of Final Decree* [D.I. 1206] (the "Final Decree") closing certain chapter 11 cases. The Lead Case, LaVie Care Centers, LLC (Case No. 24-55507) remains open. Pursuant to the Final Decree, the GUC Trustee shall be the responsible party and deemed authorized to file with the Court all documents required to close the Lead Case following the full administration of the Trust.

The attached Post-Confirmation Report was prepared based on the information provided by the Debtors in connection with the bank activity for the period August 29, 2025, through September 30, 2025. The disbursement activity presented in this Post Confirmation Report excludes the following:

- Interbank transfers
- Transfers to New Operators resulting from deposits incorrectly made into the Debtors accounts
- Transfers to the GUC Trust in connection with the Backstop Note

The GUC Trust does not take any position on the veracity of the information and documents provided by the Debtors and is solely reporting the information as provided by the Debtors.

Note that during June 2025, the initial funding for the Trust and transfers related to the Backstop Note (as defined in the Plan and Disclosure Statement) were included in the Debtors third-party disbursements for the calculation of UST Fees due. All rights of the GUC Trustee are reserved in this regard.

There may also be various immaterial variances throughout the report mostly attributed to rounding.

**Case Update**

All disbursements on account of allowed chapter 11 professional fees were paid prior to August 28, 2026. The Debtors represented to the GUC Trustee that there were no distributions on account of allowed administrative, secured or priority claims during the period.
