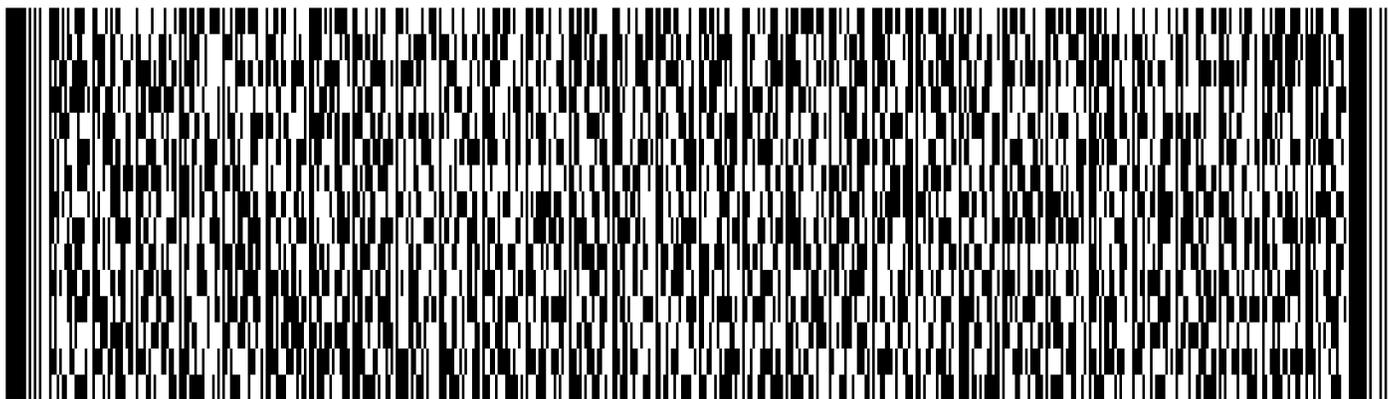

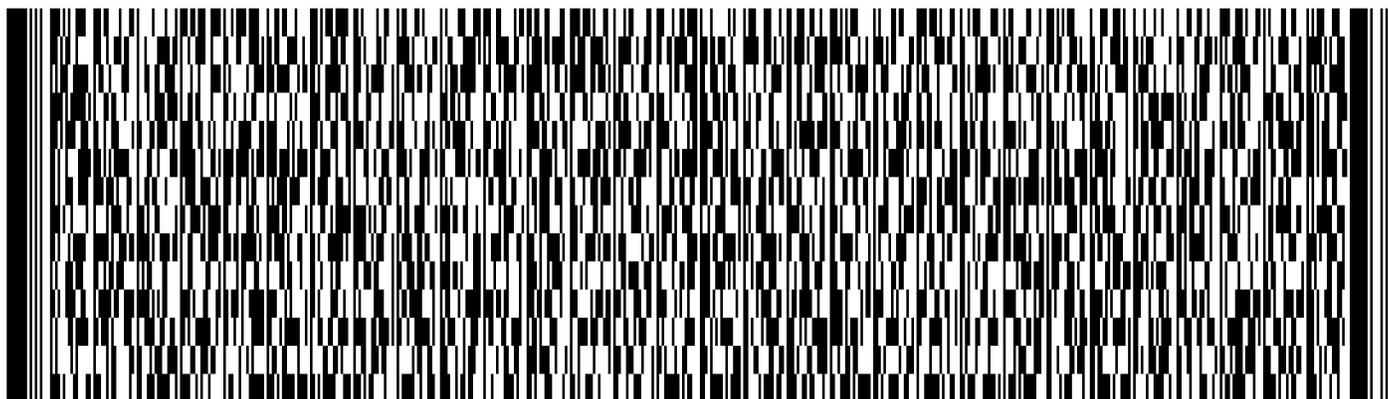
Bankruptcy Table 1-50



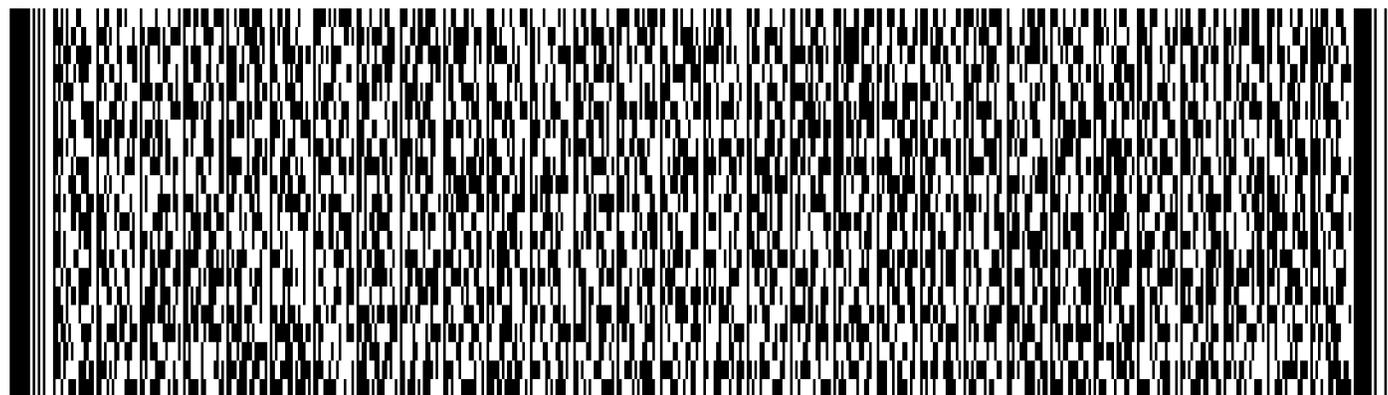
Bankruptcy Table 51-100

Notes to the Post Confirmation Report

General Notes

On June 2, 2024 (the "Petition Date"), LaVie Care Centers and the 281 other Debtor entities (combined the "Debtors") filed for protection under Chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code") in the Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Georgia, Atlanta Division (the "Bankruptcy Court").

The Debtors' *Amended Joint Chapter 11 Combined Plan and Disclosure Statement* ("Plan and Disclosure Statement") was confirmed by the Bankruptcy Court on December 5, 2024 [D.I. 735]. On June 1, 2025 ("Effective Date"), the Plan became Effective (as defined in the Plan and Disclosure Statement) and Ryniker Consultants LLC became the GUC Trustee of the LaVie Care Centers GUC Trust (the "Trust").

The Court established the following key Bar Dates for filing proofs of claim against the Debtors' estates:

- August 30, 2024 - General Bar Date
- November 29, 2024 - Governmental Bar Date
- July 1, 2025 - Rejection Damages Bar Date and Administrative Claims Bar Date

The attached Post-Confirmation Report was prepared from the best available information including, but not limited to, the GUC Trustee's bank statements, ledgers, and other available records obtained from the Debtors. All rights of the GUC Trustee are reserved in this regard.

There may also be various immaterial variances throughout the report mostly attributed to rounding.

Case Update

On or around the Effective Date, the Trust received \$10,750,000 from the Debtors in accordance with the Plan. In addition, during Q2 of 2025, the Trust received an additional \$301,000 in connection with the Backstop Note (as defined in the Plan and Disclosure Statement). On September 2, 2025, the Reorganized Debtors amended their Q2 2025 PCR for Group 1 [D.I. 1214] to include the transfers to the Trust in their schedule of quarterly disbursements for the calculation of US Trustee fees. Please note through correspondence and representations from counsel to the Reorganized Debtors, the Debtors represented that the disbursements of approximately \$11,051,000 transferred to the Trust during the second quarter were not subject to further US Trustee Fees upon disbursement to professionals or creditors of the GUC Trust. Below is a summary of the transfers from the Debtors and subsequent disbursements issued by the GUC Trust. Based on the summary, through Q4 2025 the cumulative Net GUC Assets are in excess of disbursements issued by the GUC Trust.

US Trustee fees due by the GUC Trust for the quarter are \$250.00 based on the above information.

The information contained in this post-confirmation report reflects that of only the GUC Trustee's activities. The PCR for the Lead Case will be filed separately by the GUC Trustee in connection with the Final Decree.

No distributions on account of allowed claims were issued during Q4 2025.

The GUC Trustee and his professionals continue to review claims filed against the Debtors' estates and pursue certain causes of action for potential recoveries to unsecured creditors.
