1. The Application is hereby **APPROVED** as set forth herein.

2. Province is allowed, on an interim basis, compensation in the amount of

\$255,019.00 for professional services rendered during the Compensation Period as

financial advisor to the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors of Midwest Christian

Villages Inc., et al. (the "Committee").

3. Province is allowed the reimbursement of actual and necessary expenses incurred

during the Compensation Period in connection with its services to the Committee in the

amount of \$2,139.24.

4. The Debtors are authorized and directed to remit payment to Province in the

amount of \$257,158.24, less all amounts that the Debtors previously paid to Province on

account of such fees and expenses.

5. Any payment made or to be made pursuant to this Order, and all authorization

contained herein, shall be in compliance with and subject to the Final DIP Order [Docket

No. 377] and the DIP Budget attached as Exhibit 1 thereto.

6. This Order shall be effective immediately upon entry.

(24) hours after service.
