ORDER GRANTING DEBTORS' THIRD OMNIBUS OBJECTION TO CLAIMS

Upon the objection (the "Objection") of the Debtors (the "Debtors"), pursuant to § 502(b) of the Bankruptcy Code, Bankruptcy Rule 3007, and Local Rule 3007(C), all as more fully set forth in the Objection; and this Court having jurisdiction to consider the Objection and the relief requested therein pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and consideration of the Objection and the requested relief being a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b); and it appearing that venue is proper before this Court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and the Debtors having represented that adequate and proper notice of the Objection has been given and that no other or further notice need be given; and this Court having reviewed the Objection; and this Court having held a hearing to consider the relief requested in the Objection; and this Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Objection establish just cause for the relief granted herein; and it appearing that the relief requested in the Objection is in the best interests of the Debtors and their respective estates and creditors; and upon all of the proceedings had before this Court and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Objection is **SUSTSAINED** as set forth herein.



- 2. Pursuant to § 502(b) of the Bankruptcy Code and Bankruptcy Rule 3007, the claims listed on **Schedule 1** (Claims to be Modified by Debtor) attached hereto are reclassified as indicated in the Modified Debtor column.
- 3. Pursuant to § 502(b) of the Bankruptcy Code and Bankruptcy Rule 3007, the claims listed on **Schedule 2** (Claims to be Modified by Classification) attached hereto are reclassified as indicated in the Modified Classification Column.
- 4. Pursuant to § 502(b) of the Bankruptcy Code and Bankruptcy Rule 3007, the claims listed on **Schedule 3** (Claims to be Modified as to Amount) attached hereto are modified as to the amounts indicated on the Modified Claim Amount column.
- 5. Pursuant to § 502 of the Bankruptcy Code and Bankruptcy Rule 3007, the claims listed on **Schedule 4** (No Liability Claims) are hereby disallowed.
- 6. Pursuant to § 502 of the Bankruptcy Code and Bankruptcy Rule 3007, the claims listed on **Schedule 5** (Duplicate Claims) are hereby disallowed.
 - 7. The following claim objections are resolved as follows:
 - i. The Debtors' objection to Claim No. 30-2 of UMHR was withdrawn [Docket No. 755].
- 8. The following claim objections are continued to the August 13, 2025 omnibus hearing date:
 - i. Karl Koenig f/b/o Lilliane Koenig, Claim No. 18 [Docket No. 750]. The Debtors will advise if this claim is fully resolved before the August 13, 2025 omnibus hearing date and if not, what portions are resolved and what portions require a short evidentiary hearing at the August 13, 2025 hearing.
 - 9. The terms and conditions of this Order are effective immediately upon entry.

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10. The rights of the Debtors to assert objections to any other claims filed by the

claimants (as identified on Schedules 1-5) against any of the Debtors, and on any basis, are fully

preserved.

11. Nothing contained in the Objection or this Order is intended to be or shall be

deemed as (i) an admission as to the validity of any claim against the Debtors, (ii) a waiver of the

Debtors' or any party in interest's rights to dispute the amount of, basis for, or validity of any

claim, (iii) a waiver of the Debtors' rights under the Bankruptcy Code or any other applicable

nonbankruptcy law, (iv) an agreement or obligation to pay any claims, (v) a waiver of any claims

or causes of action which may exist against any creditor or interest holder, or (vi) an approval,

assumption, adoption, or rejection of any agreement, contract, lease, program, or policy under

section 365 of the Bankruptcy Code.

12. The Debtors, the Debtors' claims and noticing agent, Verita Global, and the Clerk

of this Court are authorized to take all actions necessary or appropriate to carry out the relief

granted in this Order.

13. Not later than two (2) business days after the date of this Order, the Debtors shall

serve a copy of the Order and shall file a certificate of service no later than twenty-four (24) hours

after service
