**ORDER AUTHORIZING CLAIMS REGISTER TO BE MODIFIED PURSUANT TO
THE DEBTORS' SECOND NOTICE OF SATISFACTION OF CLAIMS**

Upon the notice (the "Notice")¹ of the above-captioned debtors and debtors-in-possession (the "Debtors") and Schedule 1 therein identifying certain claims, as defined by section 101(5) of the Bankruptcy Code, which have been fully satisfied by the Debtors (together, the "Satisfied Claims," and such claimants, the "Satisfied Claimants"); and this Court having jurisdiction pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and consideration of the Motion and the requested relief being a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b); and it appearing that venue is proper before this Court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and the Debtors having represented that adequate and proper notice of the Notice has been given and that no other or further notice need be given; and this Court having reviewed the Notice; and the Response Deadline having passed; and upon all of the proceedings had before this Court and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Debtors' have presented sufficient evidence that they have satisfied the Satisfied Claims, such claims attached hereto as Exhibit A.

2. The Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court and Kurtzman Carson Consultants, LLC d/b/a Verita Global will cause a notation to be made on the official claims and distribution registers indicating that each Satisfied Claim has been satisfied in accordance with Exhibit A.

3. The terms and conditions of this Order are effective immediately upon entry.

4. Nothing contained in this Order is intended to be or shall be deemed as (i) an admission as to the validity of any claim against the Debtors, (ii) a waiver of rights to dispute the amount of, basis for, or validity of any claim, (iii) a waiver of rights under the Bankruptcy Code or any other applicable nonbankruptcy law, (iv) an agreement or obligation to pay any claims, (v) a waiver of any claims or causes of action which may exist against any creditor or interest holder, or (vi) an approval, assumption, adoption, or rejection of any agreement, contract, lease, program, or policy under § 365 of the Bankruptcy Code.

5. Not later than two (2) business days after the date of this Order, the Debtors shall serve a copy of the Order and shall file a certificate of service no later than twenty-four (24) hours after service.
