I submit this supplemental declaration (the "Second Supplemental Declaration") in support of the *Application of the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors for Entry of an Order Authorizing the Employment and Retention of White & Case LLP as Counsel Effective as of September 9, 2025* (the "Application"), filed on October 8, 2025 [Docket No. 472],² and as a supplemental to my prior declaration in support of the Application filed as Exhibit B to the Application (the "Original Declaration") and to my first supplemental declaration in support of the Application filed October 29, 2025 [Docket No. 593] (the "First Supplemental Declaration" and, collectively, the "Prior Declaration"). 
