# GLOBAL NOTES, METHODOLOGY, AND SPECIFIC DISCLOSURES REGARDING THE DEBTORS' MONTHLY OPERATING REPORT

The accompanying Monthly Operating Report ("MOR") has been prepared by ModivCare Inc. and its debtor affiliates, as debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, the "Debtors") in the above-captioned Chapter 11 Cases, solely to comply with the reporting requirements of the Office of the United States Trustee for Region 7 (the "U.S. Trustee") and applicable bankruptcy reporting guidelines. The information contained in these global notes (these "Global Notes") is unaudited, limited in scope, and not prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles in the United States ("GAAP"). These Global Notes contain information that is applicable to each Monthly Operating Report filed in the Chapter 11 Cases contemporaneously herewith (collectively, the "Reports"), each of which corresponds to one of the Debtors' five business segments. Accordingly, the financial information presented in the Reports is subject to further review, adjustment, and reclassification as additional information becomes available. This MOR should not be relied upon for valuation, investment, or any other purpose.

1. <u>Case Number Assignments</u>. The Reports subject to these Global Notes were prepared on a business segment level rather than on a debtor-by-debtor basis. Each of the Reports is filed under the Chapter 11 Case number of the Debtor within each business segment that generated the highest level of revenue during the reporting period covered by the Reports (November 1, 2025, through November 30, 2025). The business segments presented in the Reports are consistent with the Company's customary financial reporting structure.

Pursuant to 28 CFR §58.8(b), the U.S. Trustee exercised its discretion in authorizing the Debtors to prepare these Reports using the above-described reporting approach.

A complete list of each of the Debtors in these chapter 11 cases (the "*Chapter 11 Cases*") and the last four digits of each Debtor's taxpayer identification number (if applicable) may be obtained on the website of the Debtors' claims and noticing agent at https://www.veritaglobal.net/ModivCare. Debtor ModivCare Inc.'s principal place of business and the Debtors' service address in the Chapter 11 Cases is 6900 E. Layton Avenue, Suite 1100 & 1200, Denver, Colorado 80237.

- 2. <u>Bank Account Presentation</u>. Certain bank accounts included in this MOR are presented based on their legal entity affiliation, rather than the business segment association, used in the *Emergency Motion of Debtors for Entry of Interim and Final Orders (A) Authorizing Debtors to (I) Continue Existing Cash Management System, (II) Maintain Existing Business Forms, and (III) Continue Intercompany Transactions; and (B) Granting Related Relief [Docket No. 16].*
- **3.** <u>Cash Receipts and Disbursements</u>. The cash balance beginning of the month stated in part 1 of the form represents the balance per the bank statements as of October 31, 2025.
- **4.** <u>Inventory</u>. No attachment is provided in connection with checking the "Other" inventory box on the form, as the Debtors do not hold any inventory.
- **5.** Employee and Labor Data. Because hours worked are not readily available from the Company's HR or payroll systems, the number of full-time employees reported in the MOR has been estimated based on employee census data as of November 30, 2025.

For reporting purposes, the Debtors assumed each full-time employee worked 40 hours per week, while each part-time employee worked 20 hours per week.

The total estimated hours were then divided by 173.33 average monthly hours to calculate the count of full-time equivalent employees included in the MOR. This methodology aligns with guidance provided in UST Form 11-MOR Instructions published by the United States Trustee Program.

**6.** <u>Total Postpetition Debt</u>. The total postpetition debt stated in part 2 of the form is inclusive of obligations the Debtors' received authority to pay under various "first day" orders entered by the Bankruptcy Court.
