# ADDENDUM TO PROOF OF CLAIM OF CLEAN ENERGY SERVICES CES LLC

This Proof of Claim is submitted by Clean Energy Services CES LLC (the "Claimant") and all others claiming by or through it and all successors and assigns, to preserve and claim amounts owed by Powin, LLC (the "Debtor"). Claimant expressly preserves and asserts, to the extent not stayed by 11 U.S.C. § 362, any right of setoff and recoupment and demands adequate protection thereof. Claimant hereby asserts claims against the Debtor for any and all rights and entitlement that the Claimant has or may have to indemnification, contribution, reimbursement, or other payment (including damages, attorneys' fees, costs and expenses related thereto) from Debtor pursuant to applicable contractual agreements and law.

Prior to filing for bankruptcy, the Claimant provided services to the Debtor pursuant to a Master Services Agreement (the "<u>Agreement</u>"). In accordance with the terms of the Agreement, the Claimant fully performed its obligations and provided services to the Debtor.

Pursuant to the Agreement, the Claimant issued invoices to the Debtor for payment. However, the Debtor has failed and refused to remit payment. The total outstanding balance is \$10,434,245.41. A detailed summary of the open invoices is attached as Exhibit A.

The Claimant accordingly submits this unsecured claim against the Debtor in the amount of \$10,434,245.41, along with all applicable interest and attorneys' fees permitted by law.

- a. a waiver or release the Claimant's rights or claims against any person, entity or property;
- b. a waiver of any right to setoff or recoupment;
- c. a waiver of any right to indemnification, contribution, reimbursement, or other payment (including damages, attorneys' fees, costs and expenses related thereto) from the Debtor;
- d. a waiver or release of the Claimant's right to trial by jury in any proceeding as to any matters so triable, whether or not the same are designated legal or equitable rights in any case, controversy or proceeding relating hereto, notwithstanding the designation or not of such matters as "core proceedings" pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2)(H), and whether such jury trial right is pursuant to statute or the United States Constitution;
