PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that a hearing on estate retained professionals who have filed applications for interim allowance of compensation and reimbursement of actual expenses incurred in the Chapter 11 Cases from June 9, 2025 through and including September 30, 2025<sup>2</sup> (the "First Interim Fee Period"), identified on Schedule 1 attached hereto (the "Interim Fee Applications"), has been scheduled to be heard on December 17, 2025 at 2:00 p.m. (the "Hearing") and will be conducted via Zoom for Government, before the Honorable Michael K. Kaplan, United States Bankruptcy Judge for the District of New Jersey.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, parties wishing to appear at the Hearing must register with the Court by submitting an e-mail to Chambers (chambers of mbk@njb.uscourts.gov), by no later than one business day before the hearing, by indicating the name of the person appearing, their e-mail address, their affiliation, and whom they represent/interest in this case. If the request is approved, the participant will receive appropriate credentials and further instruction. 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basis of the objection; and (c) be filed with the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court electronically by attorneys who regularly practice before the Bankruptcy Court in accordance with the General Order Regarding Electronic Means for Filing, Signing, and Verification of Documents dated March 27, 2002 (the "General Order") and the Commentary Supplementing Administrative Procedures dated as of March 2004(the "Supplemental Commentary") (the General Order, the Supplemental Commentary and the User's Manual for the Electronic Case Filing System can be found at <a href="www.njb.uscourts.gov">www.njb.uscourts.gov</a>, the official website for the Bankruptcy Court) and, by all other parties-in-interest, on CD-ROM in Portable Document Format (PDF), and shall be served on such parties in accordance with the General Order and the Supplemental Commentary, so as to be actually received no later than December 10, 2025 at 4:00 p.m. (prevailing Eastern Time) ("the Objection Deadline").
