PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT a hearing will be held on **Wednesday, April 29, 2026, at 10:30 a.m.** (the "Hearing"), and will take place at the United States Bankruptcy Court, 1300 Clay Street, Oakland, California, before the Honorable William J. Lafferty, United States Bankruptcy Judge, to consider the *Motion for an Order (I) Approving Claim Objection Procedures, (II) Approving Claim Hearing Procedures, and (III) Granting Related Relief* [Docket No. 2781] (the "Motion"), filed by The Roman Catholic Bishop of Oakland, a California corporation sole, and the debtor and debtor in possession (the "Debtor" or "RCBO") in the above-captioned chapter 11



1 The Motion seeks an order approving procedures by which the Debtor may file omnibus objections
2 to proofs of claim that have been filed or scheduled in the Chapter 11 Case and resolve any responses that
3 may be received to those objections. The proposed procedures include, but are not limited to, procedures
4 for filing omnibus objections to claims on the following grounds, in addition to those set forth in Federal
5 Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 3007(d): the claim does not include sufficient information to ascertain the
6 validity of such claim; the claim seeks recovery for which the Debtor is not liable; the claim has been
7 previously paid or settled prior to or during this Chapter 11 Case; or the claim is not supported by the
8 Debtor's books and records. For the avoidance of doubt, the Debtor intends to use the Claim Objection
9 Procedures for Sexual Abuse Claims only to object such claims as are plainly improper as a matter of law.

7 The Motion is based upon this Notice; the Motion and the memorandum of points and authorities
8 set forth therein; the declaration filed in support thereof; any and all supplemental papers that may be filed
9 by the Debtor; the papers on file in this bankruptcy case; and on such arguments or evidence as may be
10 presented at the hearing. Copies of the Motion and papers filed in support thereof, and all pleadings and
11 papers filed in this Bankruptcy Case, can be obtained from the website maintained by the Debtor's claims

16 **sought in the Motion must be in writing, filed with the Bankruptcy Court not later than seven (7)**
17 **days before the date set for the Hearing.** Any opposition must be filed in writing with Clerk of the
18 Bankruptcy Court at 1300 Clay Street, Suite 300, Oakland, California, 94612 (mailing address: P.O. Box
19 2070, Oakland, California, 94604) and must be served on counsel for the Debtor at the address listed
20 above. Unless a timely objection is filed, the Court may grant the relief requested in the Motion without
21 a hearing. **Failure to file and serve a timely objection may result in the waiver of any objection.**
