STIPULATION BETWEEN THE WIND DOWN DEBTOR
AND McDERMOTT WILL & SCHULTE LLP

[Relates to Dkt. Nos. 264 and 2327]

The Wind Down Debtor² and McDermott Will & Schulte LLP (“McDermott,” and with the Wind Down Debtor, the “Parties”), by and through their undersigned counsel, hereby stipulate and agree as set for below in this stipulation (the “Stipulation”).

RECITALS

1. On October 14, 2024, this Court entered its *Order Granting the Motion of the Debtors to Establish Procedures for Interim Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses for Professionals* [Dkt. No. 264] (the “Compensation Procedures Order”). The Compensation Procedures Order sets out the procedures for Interim and Final Fee Applications (as those terms are utilized within the Compensation Procedures Order).

2. On March 2, 2026, McDermott filed its *Twelfth and Thirteenth Monthly and Final*

Application of McDermott Will & Schulte LLP as Counsel to the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors [Dkt. No. 2327] seeking allowance and approval of certain compensation to McDermott on an interim and final basis, and reimbursement of certain expenses (the “Application”). Utilizing the Court’s negative notice procedures, the Application sets the deadline for any party to object or otherwise respond to the Application as Monday, March 23, 2026 – the 21st day after McDermott’s filing of the Application (the “Response Deadline”).

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Notwithstanding the Response Deadline or any other contrary response deadline, the Parties have agreed that the Wind Down Debtor’s deadline to file an objection or any other response to the Application is **Wednesday, April 22, 2026**.
