NOTICE OF FILING OF REVISED PROPOSED ORDER GRANTING LITIGATION
TRUSTEE’S EMERGENCY MOTION FOR AN ORDER EXTENDING THE
TERMINATION DATE OF THE LITIGATION TRUST
THROUGH AND INCLUDING MARCH 31, 2027

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT:

1. On February 18, 2026, Peter Kravitz, solely in his capacity as the Litigation Trustee (the “Litigation Trustee”) of the SpeedCast Creditor Litigation Trust, filed the *Litigation Trustee’s Emergency Motion for an Order Extending the Termination Date of the Litigation Trust Through and Including March 31, 2027* [Docket No. 2085] (the “Motion”), which attached a proposed form of order at Exhibit A to the Motion (the “Initial Proposed Order”).
2. At a hearing held February 27, 2026 at 10:00 a.m. CT (the “Hearing”) before the Honorable Marvin Isgur, the Court granted the Motion subject to the Litigation Trustee making certain modifications to the Initial Proposed Order for the reasons set forth by the Court at the Hearing.
3. To reflect the Court’s oral ruling, the Litigation Trustee hereby files a revised proposed order granting the Motion. attached hereto as Exhibit A (the “Revised Proposed Order”).

**ORDER GRANTING LITIGATION TRUSTEE’S MOTION FOR AN ORDER
EXTENDING THE TERMINATION DATE OF THE LITIGATION TRUST
THROUGH AND INCLUDING MARCH 31, 2027**

Upon the motion (the “Motion”)², the Court having reviewed the Motion and the responses thereto, if any, and the Court finding that the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); that notice of the Motion was sufficient under the circumstances and that no other or further notice need be given; and the Court having determined that the legal and factual grounds set forth in the Motion establish just cause for the relief granted herein; and the Court having determined that the relief granted herein is necessary to facilitate or complete the disposition of claims and causes of action assigned to the Litigation Trust and that it is in the best interest of the Litigation Trust, its beneficiaries and the creditors of the Reorganized Debtors’ estates; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion is GRANTED as set forth herein.

2. In accordance with Article V, Section 5.20(o) of the Plan and Section 10.1 of the Litigation Trust Agreement, the term of the Litigation Trust is hereby extended through and including **March 31, 2027** (the "Litigation Trust Extension").

3. The Litigation Trust Extension is granted without prejudice to the Litigation Trustee seeking an additional extension of the term of the Litigation Trust.

4. The Litigation Trustee shall make a primary distribution of the Litigation Trust Distributable Proceeds to the Litigation Trust Beneficiaries (each as defined in the Litigation Trust Agreement) on or before **June 30, 2026**, with such distribution to be made in accordance with the terms of the Litigation Trust Agreement. This term of the Order is without prejudice to the Litigation Trustee making subsequent distributions, if any, to Litigation Trust Beneficiaries after June 30, 2026.

5. The terms and conditions of this Order will be immediately effective and enforceable upon its entry.

6. Except with respect to the term of the Litigation Trust, which is specifically extended as set forth herein, and the requirement for the Litigation Trustee to make a primary distribution to Litigation Trust Beneficiaries on or before June 30, 2026, all other terms of the Litigation Trust Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
