**ORDER AUTHORIZING THE TRUSTEE TO FILE OMNIBUS  
OBJECTIONS TO CERTAIN CLAIMS FILED AGAINST THE ESTATE**

Upon consideration of the motion (the “Motion”) of Kenneth P. Silverman, Esq., the chapter 7 trustee (the “Trustee”) for the bankruptcy estate of Buth-Na-Bodhaige, Inc. (the “Debtor”) seeking entry of an order, pursuant to Rule 3007(c) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the “Bankruptcy Rule”), authorizing omnibus claims objections to certain claims filed against the Debtor’s estate (the “Omnibus Objections”); and it appearing that the relief requested is in the best interests of the Debtor’s estate, its creditors, and all parties-in-interest; and good and sufficient notice having been provided as set forth in the Motion; and notice of the Motion, the Hearing, and the relief sought in the Motion having been good and sufficient under the circumstances; and upon the Certificate of No Objection filed on October 15, 2024 at ECF Doc. No. 127; and the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Motion establishing sufficient cause for the relief requested; it is hereby

**ORDERED**, that the Motion is granted; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 3007(c), the Debtor is authorized to object to multiple Claims in Omnibus Objections; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that the Omnibus Objections shall (a) state in a conspicuous place that claimants receiving the objection should locate their names and claims in the objection; (b) list claimants alphabetically, provide a cross-reference to claim numbers, and, if appropriate, list



claimants by category of claims; (c) state the grounds of the objection to each claim and provide a cross-reference to the pages in the omnibus objection pertinent to the stated grounds; (d) state in the title the identity of the objector and the grounds for the objections; (e) be numbered consecutively with other omnibus objections filed by the same objector; and (f) contain objections to no more than 50 claims.
