Francisco Aguirre appeared pro se in response to the Order to Show Cause and as a representative of Beyond Attorneys LLC, with whom he claimed to no longer be affiliated with. L. Beltran failed to appear or respond (reportedly hospitalized). The following Movants appeared pro se: Jorge Enrique Aguirre, Yosvanys Garcia Diaz, Richard Gildardo Armenta, Salomon Vaquera Oviedo, Mayra Alejandra Robledo Moreno, Angel Celiseo Ceronio, Johanna Ruby Vasquez Zermeno, Brisa Viridiana Martinez Ibarra, Jose Alberto Ferrer Suarez, Jose Eduardo Alas Linares, Jeronimo Gonzalez Isidro, Erminio Melchor Morales, Evaristo Valle Mendoza, Juan Pablo Frigoli Campos, German Augusto Hoyos Baquero, Maria Alejandra Otega, Juan Calafell Martinez, Maria Isabel Vasquez and Karla Celina De Santiago Chavez. Status Conference Held on Order to Show Cause. Francisco Aguirre, Brisa Viridiana Martinez, Maria Isabel Vasquez, Jorge Enrique Aguirre, and Yosvanys Garcia Diaz each testified. Court issued sua sponte TEMPORARY moratorium on repossessions by Vervent, Inc. for the time period from 2/20/26 at noon CT to 3/23/26 at noon CT. The moratorium shall be put in place to allow Vervent, the Trustee and other interested parties time to establish improved communications with Tricolor customers with respect to Vervents appointment as backup servicer and its ongoing collection activities on

behalf of the estate and other secured lenders. The moratorium is designed to be temporary. As will be further set out in the Order, the moratorium does not apply to agreed surrenders, notices of intent to sell, repossessions currently in process, repossessions of impounded vehicles, or auction sales of previously repossessed vehicles. The Court set Dkt. Nos. 655, 676-690 for final, in person evidentiary hearing on April 1, 2016 at 9:30 a.m. Movants to notice hearings. The Court further deemed Dkt. Nos. 718-723 to request relief from the stay by their terms and therefore be subject to a fee requirement. If the fee for such motions is not paid by 2/24/26, such motions will be denied sua sponte. Any other motion filed by similarly situated movants, requesting relief from the stay by its terms and subject therefore to a fee requirement, shall be subject to the same conditions. If the fee is not paid within 7 days of filing, the motion shall be subject to dismissal sua sponte. The Court will hold further proceedings with respect to the actions taken by Beyond Attorneys LLC, Francisco Aguirre and Lluvia Beltran and whether their actions relative to Dkt Nos. 655, 676-690, and 718-723 constitute the unauthorized practice of law or are otherwise violative of Tex. Govt. Code Ann. 81.01 or other applicable law. The foregoing list of filings is not intended to be exclusive. A separate notice of hearing shall issue with respect to such further hearing.)).
