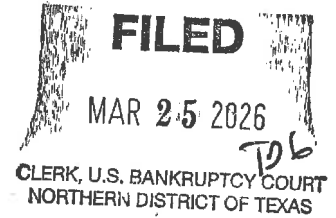

MOTION OF LLUVIA MEDINA BELTRAN TO APPEAR REMOTELY AT HEARING

TO THE HONORABLE UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY JUDGE: MICHELLE V. LARSON

COMES NOW, **Lluvia Medina Beltran**, appearing pro se, and respectfully moves this Court for entry of an order permitting her to appear remotely, via Zoom or other video conference platform, at the hearing currently scheduled for **April 1, 2026 at 9:30 a.m.**, and states as follows:

1. Movant is an individual residing in the State of Arizona and is not a resident of the State of Texas.
2. Movant has significant personal and logistical constraints that make in-person attendance in Dallas, Texas extremely difficult.
3. Specifically, Movant is the primary caregiver for her minor children and does not currently have available childcare that would allow her to travel out of state for the scheduled hearing.
4. Additionally, Movant is employed part-time as a caregiver and has ongoing work obligations that limit her ability to travel.
5. Movant respectfully submits that appearing remotely will not prejudice any party and will allow her to fully participate in the proceedings while maintaining her caregiving responsibilities.
6. Movant is willing and able to appear via Zoom or any remote platform designated by the Court and will comply with all procedures required for remote participation.



7. This request is made in good faith and not for purposes of delay.

Movant respectfully requests that this Court enter an order permitting her to appear remotely at the April 1, 2026 hearing, and for such other and further relief as the Court deems just and proper.
