Upon the motion (the “**Motion**”)<sup>1</sup> of the above-captioned debtors (collectively, the “**Debtors**”) for entry of an order (this “**Order**”) authorizing the Debtors to (a) direct procedural consolidation and joint administration of the Chapter 11 Cases for procedural purposes only, and (b) grant certain related relief; and the Court having jurisdiction to decide the Motion and to enter this Order pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1334; and these chapter 11 cases having been referred to this Court by standing order of the U.S. District Court for the District of New Jersey; and consideration of the Motion being a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b) upon which this Court may enter a final order consistent with Article III of the U.S. Constitution; and venue being proper in the Court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and due and proper notice of the Motion having been provided, such that no other or further notice is required or necessary under the circumstances; and the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Motion and in the record establish just cause for entry of this Order; it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. The Motion is **GRANTED** as set forth herein.
2. The above-captioned Chapter 11 Cases are consolidated for procedural purposes only and shall be jointly administered by the Court under Case No. 25-23630 (MBK) (the “**Lead Case**”).
3. The Debtors shall maintain, and the Clerk of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Jersey shall keep, one consolidated docket, one file, and one consolidated service list for these jointly administered cases.
4. All lists, schedules, and statements shall be filed and docketed in the specific Debtor’s case to which they are applicable.
5. The Debtors shall file individual monthly operating reports for each Debtor and such reports shall be docketed in the Lead Case.
