**SUPPLEMENTAL DECLARATION OF AVI ROBBINS
IN SUPPORT OF THE RETENTION AND EMPLOYMENT OF
PJT PARTNERS LP, AS INVESTMENT BANKER TO DEBTORS AND DEBTORS IN
POSSESSION, EFFECTIVE AS OF THE PETITION DATE**

I, Avram Robbins, hereby declare:

1. I am a Partner at the Restructuring and Special Situations Group at PJT Partners LP (“PJT”), investment banker for United Site Services, Inc. and its debtor affiliates, as debtors and debtors-in-possession (collectively, the “Debtors”) in the above captioned chapter 11 cases.

2. On January 6, 2026, the Debtors filed the *Debtor’s Application for Entry of an Order Authorizing the Retention and Employment of PJT Partners LP as Investment Banker to the Debtors and Debtors in Possession Effective as of the Petition Date* (Docket No. 138) (the “Application”).²

3. In connection with the Application, I submitted an initial declaration (the “Initial Declaration”) describing PJT’s connections to the Debtors and other potential parties in interest (the “PII”). The Initial Declaration was attached to the Application as Exhibit B.

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4. I hereby submit this supplemental declaration to describe the below additional connections of PJT to the PII.

5. PJT (and/or its financial advisory affiliates) has been engaged within the last three years, is currently engaged by, or has another connection to, the following PIIs (or one or more of their affiliates, as the case may be) in matters unrelated to the Debtors and these Chapter 11 Cases (including where one of the PII was only a member of an official or an ad hoc creditor committee or an equity committee):

- a. One of the PJT analysts who is working on the engagement for the Debtors has accepted employment with an affiliate of Oaktree, one of the PIIs, following the conclusion of his two-year analyst program.
- b. PJT has been engaged to provide financial advisory services to an affiliate of Security Benefit, one of the PIIs, in a confidential matter.
- c. PJT previously retained Skadden, Arps, Slate, Meagher & Flom LLP and Hon. Robert D. Drain (Ret.), appointed to serve as mediator in these chapter 11 cases, in connection with the receivership of Theia Group.
