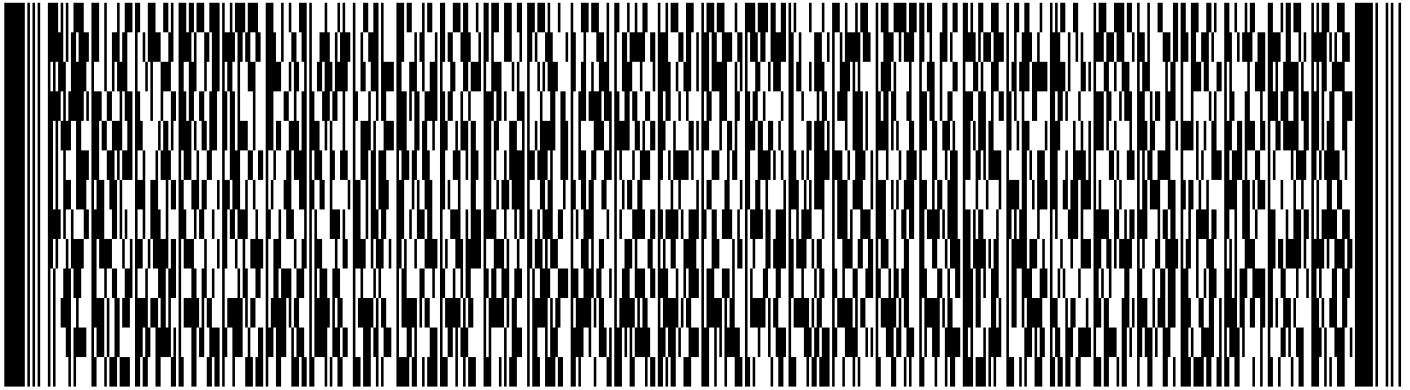

Bankruptcy Table 1-50

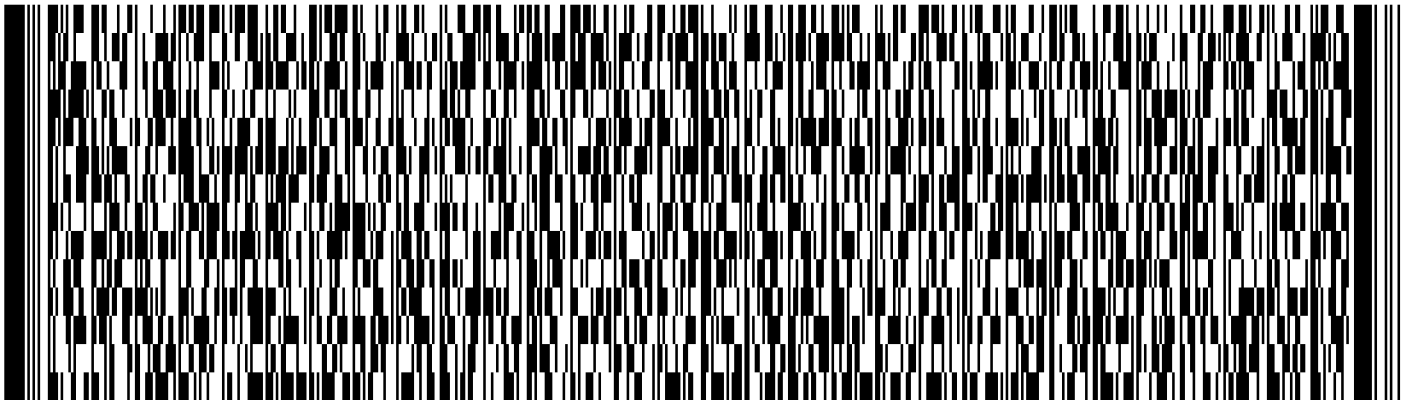
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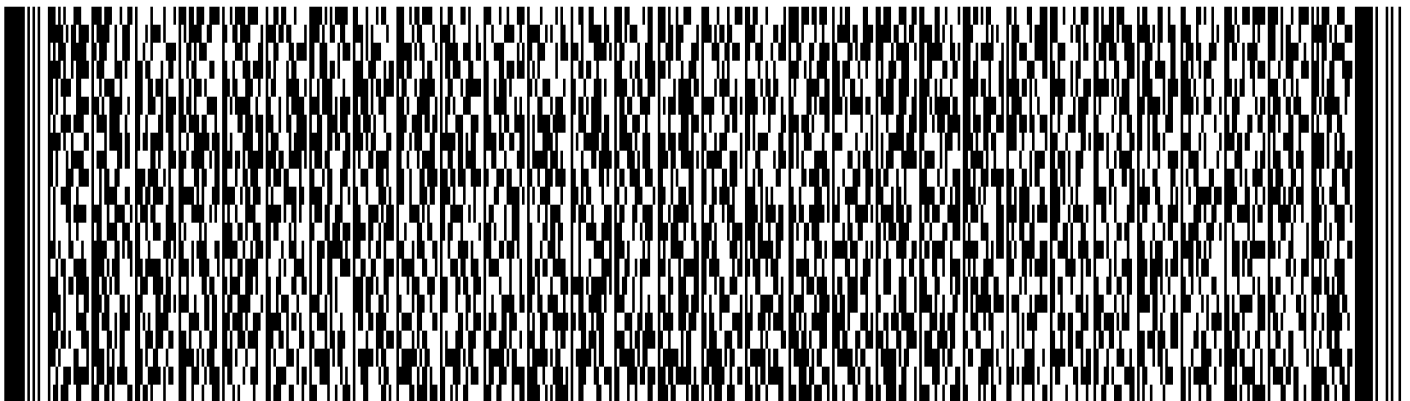


Bankruptcy Table 51-100
