**ORDER GRANTING DEBTORS'

possession (collectively, the “Debtors”) seeking authorization to allow (i) its Chief Restructuring Officer and additional personnel, David Baker, Greg Baker, and Che Carrasquillo of Aurora Management Partners (the “Chief Restructuring Officer and Additional Personnel”), and (ii) its investment bankers, Teri Stratton, Ping Xiao, and Richard Klein of Hilco Corporate Finance, LLC (“Investment Bankers”), to bring electric equipment into the courtroom for use during hearings in these Chapter 11 Cases. The Court having considered the Motion and all papers related thereto, and finding that the relief requested in the Motion is warranted, it is hereby

ORDERED THAT the Chief Restructuring Officer and Additional Personnel and Investment Bankers may each bring one (1) cell phone and one (1) laptop or tablet computer (“Equipment”) to Courtroom 1201, the Richard B. Russell Federal Building & U.S. Courthouse, 75 Ted Turner Drive, S.W., Atlanta, Georgia 30303, in conjunction with hearings in these Chapter 11 Cases. This authorization shall begin on Thursday, August 21, 2025 and continue until completion of these Chapter 11 Cases. Said Equipment shall be subject to inspections and proper identification will be required upon entering the security station at the courthouse. Proposed counsel for the Debtors, through Kurtzman Carson Consultants, LLC d/b/a Verita Global (“Verita”) shall cause a copy of this Order to be served by electronic mail or first class mail, as applicable, on the United States Trustee, counsel to the official committee of unsecured creditors appointed in the Debtors’ cases, and the United States Marshal’s Office.

This court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from or related to the implementation or enforcement of this Order.
