**NOTICE OF PLEADINGS, DEADLINE TO OBJECT AND HEARING**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Committee of Creditors Holdings Unsecured Claims (“Committee”) of Wellmade Floor Coverings International, Inc. (“Coverings”), and Wellmade Industries MFR. N.A, LLC (“MFR,” collectively, “Debtors”), have filed the following interim applications for compensation and reimbursement of expenses:

- 1) *First Interim Application for Compensation and for Reimbursement of Expenses of Pachulski Stang Ziehl & Jones LLP as Counsel for the Committee of Creditors Holding Unsecured Claims for the Period from August 18, 2025 through December 31, 2025* (the “**PSZJ Application**”), in which Pachulski Stang Ziehl & Jones, LLP, is seeking an order approving on an interim basis its fees in the amount of \$ of \$291,917.00 and expenses in the amount of \$1,575.76 from August 19, 2025 through December 31, 2025, as administrative expenses in the cases and authorizing payment by Debtors/Debtors-in-Possession of any remaining balance due to PSZJ.
- 2) *First Interim Application for Compensation for Small Herrin, LLP, as Local Counsel for the Committee of Creditors Holdings Unsecured Claims* (“**SH Application**”), in which Small Herrin, LLP, is seeking an order approving on an interim basis its fees in the amount of \$39,776.00 (Coverings - \$20,693.00; MFR - \$19,083.00) and expenses in the amount of \$1,878.65 (Covering \$449.95; MFR - \$1,428.70) from August 19, 2025 through December 31, 2025, as administrative expenses in the cases and authorizing payment by Debtors/Debtors-in-Possession of any remaining balance due to SH.
- 3) *First Interim Application for Compensation for Dundon Advisers, LLC, as Financial Advisors for the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors of Wellmade Floor Coverings International, Inc., and Wellmade Industries MFR N.A., LLC* (“**Dundon Application**,” collectively with the PSZJ Application and the SH Application, the “**Applications**”), in which Dundon Advisers, LLC, is seeking an order approving on

an interim basis its fees in the amount of \$108,507.50 and expenses in the amount of \$0.00 from August 19, 2025 through November 30, 2025, as administrative expenses in the cases and authorizing payment by Debtors/Debtors-in-Possession of any remaining about due to Dundon.

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that pursuant to the Fifth Amended and Restated General Order No. 24-2018, the Court may consider these matters without further notice or a hearing if no party in interest files a response or objection **on or before February 5, 2026**. If you object to the relief requested in any one or more of these pleading, you must timely file your objection with the Bankruptcy Clerk at: **Clerk of Court, United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Georgia, Atlanta Division, Room 1340, 75 Ted Turner Drive, SW, Atlanta, GA 30303**, and serve the below counsel for the Committee and any other appropriate persons by the objection deadline. The response or objection must explain your position and be actually received by the Bankruptcy Clerk within the required time.

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that the Court will hold a hearing on the Applications at **1:30 p.m. on February 11, 2026, in Courtroom 1201, United States Courthouse, 75 Ted Turner Drive, SW, Atlanta, GA 30303**.

If an objection or response is timely filed and served, the hearing will proceed as scheduled as to the Applications, as applicable. **If you do not file a response or objection within the time permitted, the Court may grant the relief requested without further notice and without holding the scheduled hearing** provided that an order approving the relief requested is entered at least one business day prior to the scheduled hearing. If no objection is timely filed, but no order is entered granting the relief requested at least one business day prior to the scheduled hearing, the hearing will be held as scheduled.

**Your rights may be affected. You should read these papers carefully and discuss them with your attorney, if you have one in this bankruptcy case. If you do not have an attorney, you may wish to consult one.**
