## Attachment to Proof of Claim of 615 S. Thornton Avenue, LLC

615 S. Thornton Avenue, LLC (the "Landlord") and Windstream Corporation, predecessor in interest of Windstream Services, LLC (the "Debtor"), are parties to a certain Lease dated as of July 11, 2014 concerning certain real property located at 615 S. Thornton Avenue in Dalton, Georgia (the "Lease").

Because the Lease is voluminous and in the possession of the Debtor, it is not attached hereto. The Landlord will provide a copy of the Lease upon request.

As of February 25, 2019 (the "Petition Date"), the Landlord was not aware of any fixed and liquidated obligations owed by the Debtor under the Lease.

The Landlord may have contingent and/or unliquidated claims against the Debtor arising under various provisions of the Lease, including the Debtor's obligation to indemnify the Landlord under Article 16 of the Lease.

The Landlord is the beneficiary of a letter of credit in the amount of \$377,340.00 supporting the Debtor's obligations under the Lease.

The Landlord reserves the rights (a) to file a claim or request for payment pursuant to Section 503(b) or Section 507(a) of the Bankruptcy Code and generally to make requests for payment of administrative expenses; and (b) to amend and/or supplement this Proof of Claim in any respect.
