

## Sale Close Vendor FAQ

August 8, 2024

### 1. How do I know if my contract was assumed or rejected?

To see if your contract has been assumed and assigned to Labcorp, please review the *Supplemental Notice to Contract Parties to Assumed Executory Contracts* [Docket No. 884, linked [here](#)] and the *Amended Notice to Contract Parties to Assumed Executory Contracts and Unexpired Leases* [Docket No. 923, linked [here](#)].

The Debtors filed a schedule of contracts being assumed by the bankruptcy wind down estate and a schedule of contracts being rejected as supplements to the *Third Amended Joint Plan of Invitae Corporation and its Debtor Affiliates Pursuant to Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code* [Docket No. 924 Exhibits B and C, linked [here](#)]. The Debtors' contracts that are not included on the contract assumption notices or schedule are deemed rejected under the Plan, even if the contract is not included on the Debtors' rejection schedule.

### 2. How do I submit an outstanding invoice for goods / services provided to Invitae prior to sale close on August 5, 2024?

You can file a claim with the Verita (formerly KCC) team *within 30 days of the effective date* for any pre-close goods or services provided between February 13, 2024 and August 4, 2024. To file a claim, please go to <https://veritaglobal.net/invitae> and fill out the claim form.

### 3. What is the effective date?

The effective date is August 7, 2024.

### 4. What should I do if I have an outstanding invoice for goods / services provided to Invitae after sale close?

Invoices covering both the pre- and post-sale close period should be split into two separate invoices. The invoice covering the pre-close period (prior to August 5, 2024) can be filed with Verita (formerly KCC). To file a claim, please go to <https://www.veritaglobal.net/invitae> to download a claim form. Invoices for goods / services provided on or after August 5, 2024 should be sent to Labcorp.

For example, an invoice for the period August 1–31, 2024 should be split into two invoices. One invoice should cover August 1–4, 2024 and be filed as a claim. A second invoice covering August 5–31, 2024 should be sent to Labcorp.

### 5. When can I expect to receive a distribution for my claim?

Your claim will be handled as part of the bankruptcy estate wind down process. Unfortunately, we cannot provide an exact timeline, but please know we are working expeditiously to handle all outstanding claims.
